MultiMedia Memory Montages

1. Project Objectives:

Our Advanced MultiMedia class at Thomas Worthington High School focuses on the development of advanced graphic design and multimedia skills and techniques. Using computer technology and the digital images found on the Worthington Memory Web Site, students would create a Worthington Memory Montage.

2. Project Description:

Montage: one unified image, created by blending many different images.

Students may choose to focus on historic images or may combine them with contemporary images.

The composite images will be at least 18"x 24". They will be printed and mounted. The students have never created an image larger than 8 x 10, due to printing constraints. The grant money will be used to have these images printed.

Montages will be given to the Worthington Memory Project.

3. Project Time line:

The students will work on this project during the 2nd Semester. All work will be completed by June 6, 2003.

4. Evaluation:

Students will be evaluated on the utilization of advanced PhotoShop techniques. Students will be evaluated on their ability to use a variety of advanced PhotoShop techniques. The goal is to create one, composite image from many individual images.

Color printing: \$10/sq ft

18x24 = \$30
