Dear Parents of Juniors and Seniors:

The Worthington High School Junior-Senior Prom, scheduled this year on Saturday, April 26, is a special event for our students. It is an exciting evening, but often the celebration leads to activities which pose safety problems and may violate the law. In the past many students have planned and attended motel parties, where alcohol has been served, prior to and after the prom.

The Worthington Activity Club, a high school parent support group, and other concerned parents believed an alternative should be found to these types of activities. We have planned "Afterhours," an all-night party after the prom as a fun and safe alternative for our students. The event, which will be held in the beautiful, new Westerville Athletic Club, is for all Worthington High School juniors and seniors. The party is a wonderful opportunity for students who do not attend the prom to have a special evening to remember, and no "date" is necessary.

"Afterhours" is the name chosen by the Junior-Senior Student Committee helping to plan this party. Tickets are a real bargain! They will be \$10 if purchased by April 14, and \$15 after that date. This low price allows the student to participate in the entire evening's program. Included are swimming, racquetball, "walleyball," disk jockey and dancing, movies and lots of good food from the hours of midnight to 4:30 a.m. There will be door prizes given throughout the evening and a grand prize at the end.

In order to encourage attendance at "Afterhours," we are asking parents to purchase a ticket for their child. Tickets will not be issued without a permission slip and will not be sold at the door! To purchase a ticket, fill out the enclosed permission slip with your student's full name and send a check for the correct amount payable to CCB -- "Afterhours" with a self-addressed stamped envelope. Tickets will be mailed within 10 days prior to the party.

Since this party is the first of its kind for Worthington, we need extra support from parents. 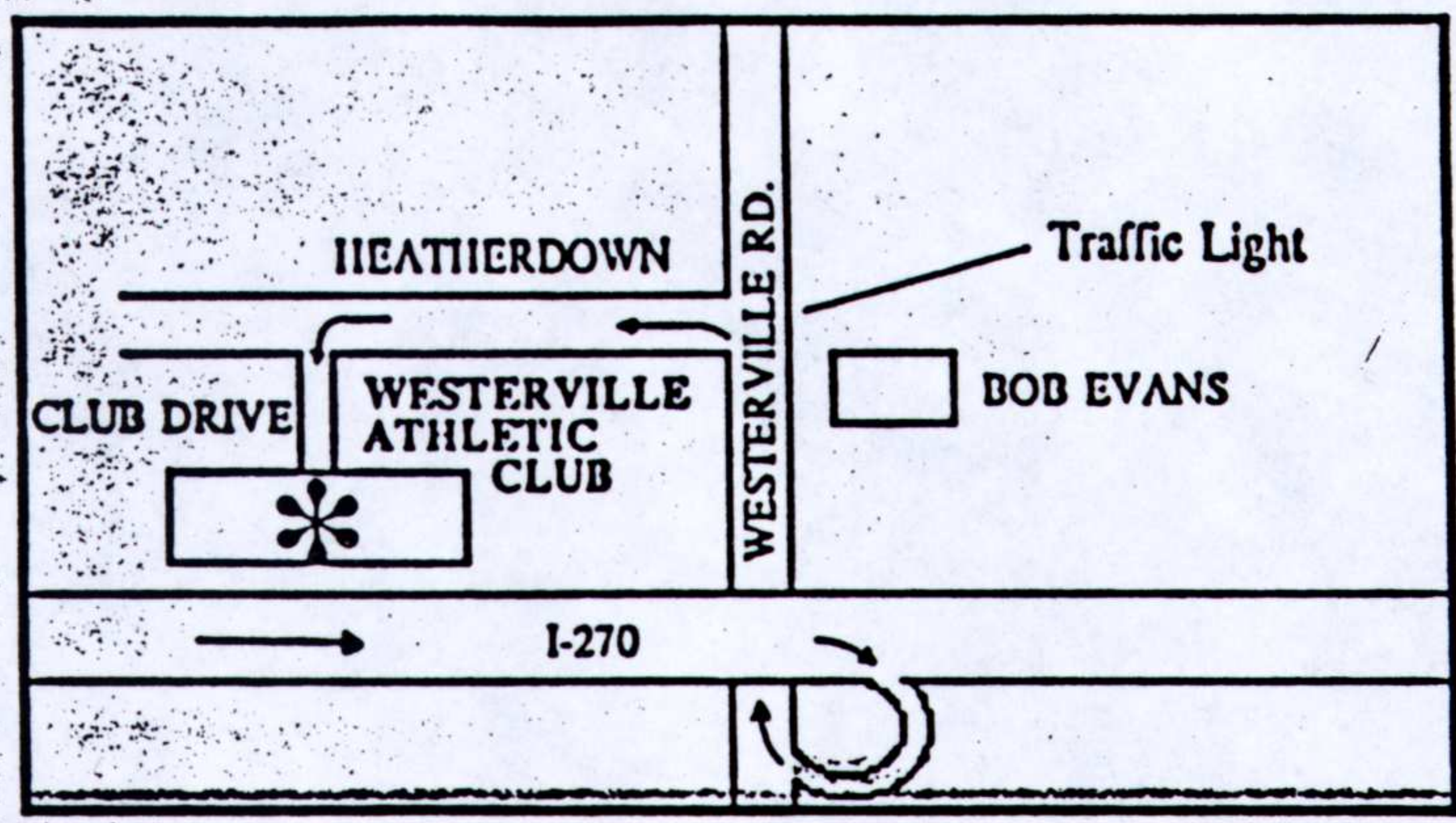

RULES OF THE WESTERVILLE ATHLETIC CLUB:

1. There is to be no consumption of alcoholic beverages, tobacco, or any mood altering chemical substance.
2. Eating will be confined to the cafeteria and movie areas.
3. Chaperones will be present at a 1 to 6 ratio to students.
4. House rules for each activity will be posted and observed.
5. Police protection required inside and outside facility.
6. Only white sole court shoes will be permitted on athletic and dancing surfaces when participating.
7. Lockers, towels and game equipment can be borrowed upon deposit of a school I.D. or drivers license. I.D. will be returned when equipment is returned.
8. There are only 293 parking spaces; car pooling is recommended.

PARTY RULES:

1. Hours of the party are 12:00 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. We encourage students to spend the entire time at "Afterhours."
2. Due to the nature of the party, with its many physical activities, a student must have a valid permission slip (INCLUDING A BACK UP EMERGENCY NUMBER CONTACT) turned in, in order to purchase a ticket.
3. Once a student enters "Afterhours," he/she must stay, in order to remain part of the party. If a student leaves, returning is not possible.
4. Any Junior or Senior at Worthington High School may attend. From dates from other classes or schools are welcome provided that a valid, signed permission slip is presented and ticket purchased by a parent through the mail or during ticket sales at school during the lunch hour. No permission slip - no ticket.
5. Prizes will be awarded throughout the night. A student will deposit the ticket stub upon entry. He/She must be present to claim the prize. Identification (student I.D. or drivers license) must accompany the claim.

This will be a very exciting evening for our party goers, however, it will be necessary to keep the enthusiasm under control, for we are the guest of Westerville Athletic Club. All WAC and party rules must be followed. Unacceptable behavior will not be tolerated. We wish to return for future "Afterhours".

PARTY RULES:

1. Hours of the party are 12:00 a.m. - 4:30 p.m.
2. In case of an emergency, resulting from the physical activities of the party, a parent must provide a phone number where he/she can be reached, along with an alternate, local number (neighbor, friend, relative). This form must be presented in order to purchase a ticket.
3. If a student leaves "Afterhours", he/she may not return.
4. Any Junior or Senior at Worthington High School may attend. From dates from other classes or schools are welcome provided that a valid, signed permission slip is presented and ticket purchased by a parent through the mail or during ticket sales at school during the lunch hour. NO PERMISSION SLIP - NO TICKET.
5. Prizes will be awarded throughout the night, 1st big prize at 1:00 a.m. He/She must be there and present identification (student I.D. or drivers license) to win.

POLICY FOR DEALING WITH
INTOXICATED AND INAPPROPRIATE BEHAVIOR
OF STUDENT GUESTS

1. INTOXICATED BEHAVIOR

- A. Admit Student
- B. Observe and assess behavior - Linda Beegle, R.N. -
Director of Education for Talbot Hall
- C. If the student's health and safety is in question,
he/she will be taken to a special room for further
observation. A decision will be made as to:
 - 1. calling the parents or emergency number
given on the permission slip, expressing
concern for the student's safety and ask
for parental assistance. If no one can be
reached for assistance, Officer Brown will
determine a safe course of action.
 - 2. limiting the involvement in physical acti-
vities available. The police officer
inside, Ray Brown of the Worthington
Police, will enforce any restrictions.
- D. Each student needing the above attention will have
his/her name placed on a list to be kept at the
table at the front door.
- E. The committee making decisions, regarding the above, will
be the Co-Chairmen, Susie Blackford and Mary
Greenlee, Linda Beegle, R.N., and Ray Brown,
Worthington Police, inside officer.
- F. All Contacts of this nature will be done in as
unagressive a manner as possible.
 - 1. Where possible, female students will be
approached by female parents.
 - 2. Where possible, male students will be
approached by male parents.
- G. The student's safety will be of primary concern at all times.

II. INAPPROPRIATE BEHAVIOR

- A. Students will be admitted.
- B. Students will be observed and assessed by all chaperones.
- C. Chaperones will report observations of inappropriate
behavior to the front desk, if this behavior is some-
thing they can't deal with or if they need assistance.
- D. Female chaperones should approach female guests, if possible.
Male chaperones should approach male guests, if possible.
- E. Any chemical substance found by chaperones should be
confiscated and taken to the front desk.
- F. Any drinking or ingesting of a chemical substance will
result in expulsion. Parents will be called and be
asked to come get their child. If no parent or
emergency number can be reached, Officer Ray Brown will
determine the safest course of action.

TIME: 11:00 p.m. - 5:00 a.m.

PRICE: \$1,500 - All facilities except Fitness Center
\$1,000 - All facilities except Fitness Center and Outdoor Pool

CLEAN-UP TIME: 5:00 a.m. - 7:30 a.m.
School is responsible for clean-up after party. Club is to be left the way it was found. All trash must be bagged & taken to dumpster.

DEPOSIT: A deposit of ^{\$200 sw} \$500 is required within 10 days of requesting date in order to confirm party date. This deposit will be returned within two weeks after party. It may not be applied to amount due club.

PAYMENT: Final payment is due Club by day before party. This does not include deposit.

FACILITIES: FITNESS CENTER - no one is to be in fitness center for any reason .

CAFE - Cafe counter top and outlets may be used. Refrigerators-stoves - coffee pots - soft drink dispensers are NOT TO BE USED !!!

R.B. COURTS - Wally Ball must be set up & taken down by school.

LOCKER ROOMS - Amenities (shampoo, spray, etc.) may be used but may not be abused. NO TOWELS WILL BE ISSUED WITHOUT FORM OF I.D. !!!

POOL - Club will provide life guards. They are not to be used for supervisory people- this is up to school chaperones.

NOTE: Supervision will be one adult to every 3 or 4 party guests. Chaperones must be stationed at every exit and locker rooms. Anyone leaving club will be unable to re-enter. School will pay for 2 policeman. One will be inside the Club and the other will be in parking lot. School may provide refreshments or may choose to have Club.
