


The program's carefully designed classes address:

Nearly 100 graduates of the course have developed 28 group projects which directly benefit the community. One ongoing project is Service Day. Teams of alumni and class members, service clubs, corporations and students paint, pick up trash, run errands and do other odd jobs to assist needy residents and beautify the community. Individuals who volunteer their services collect pledges from family members, friends and co-workers.
