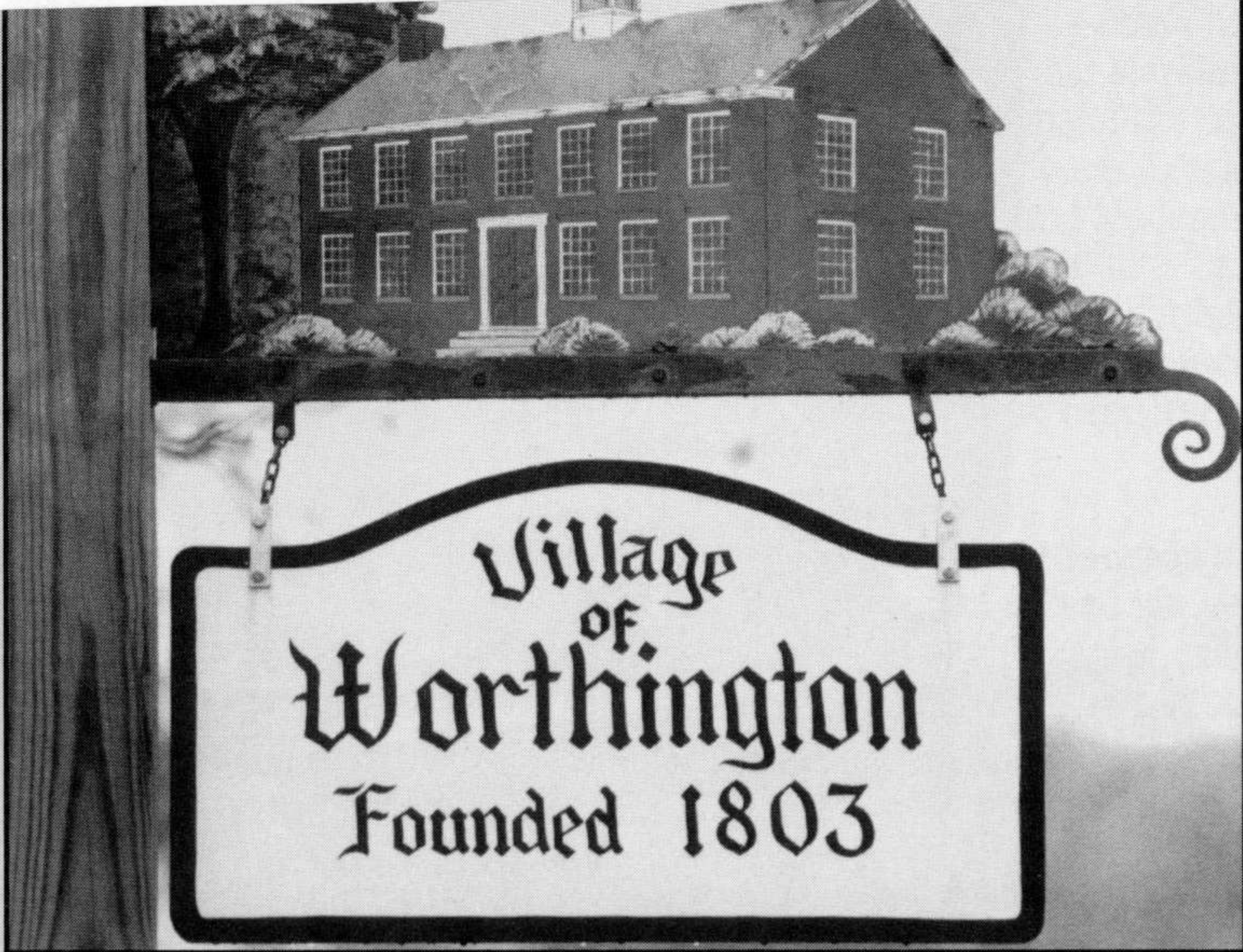

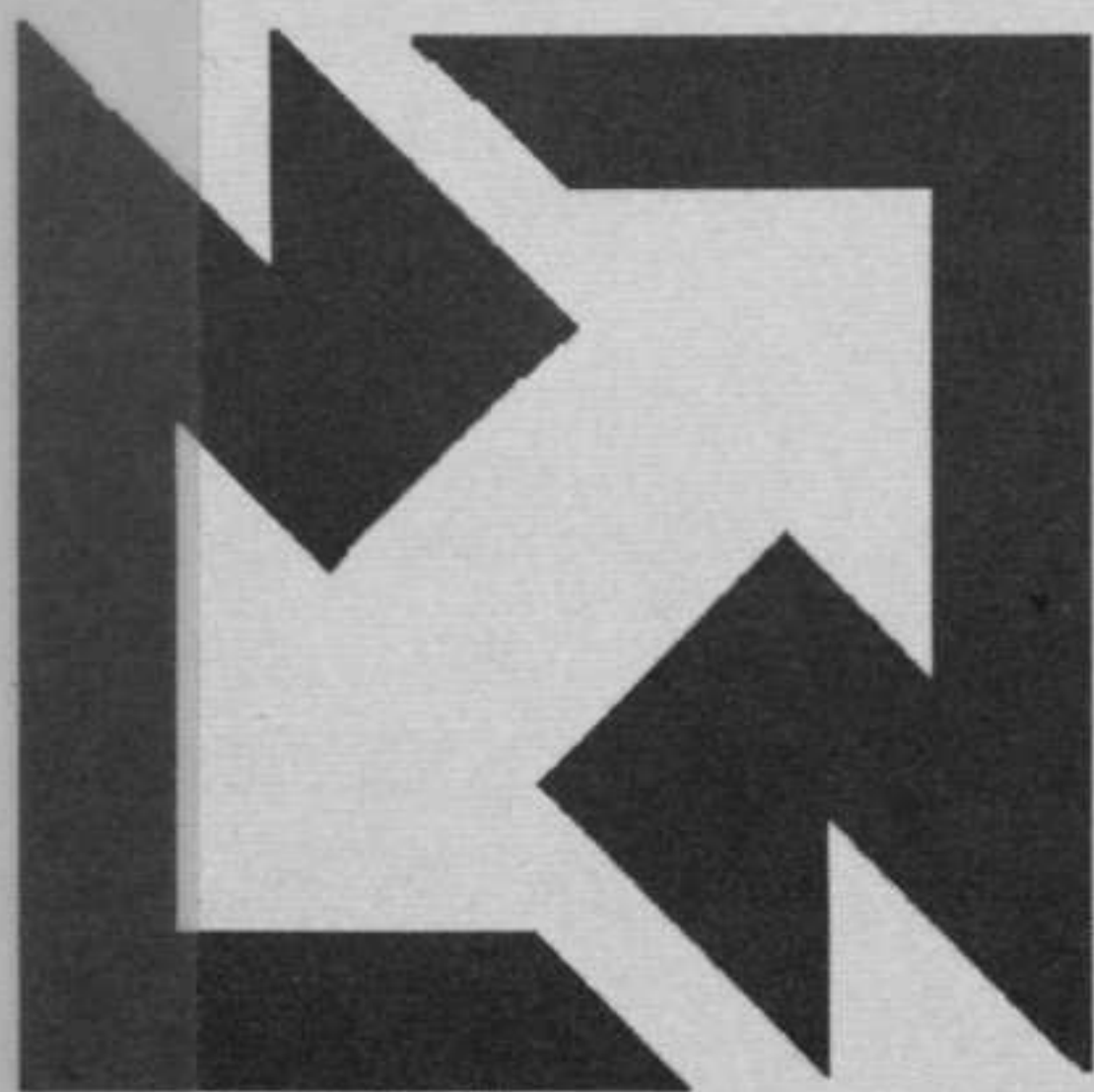

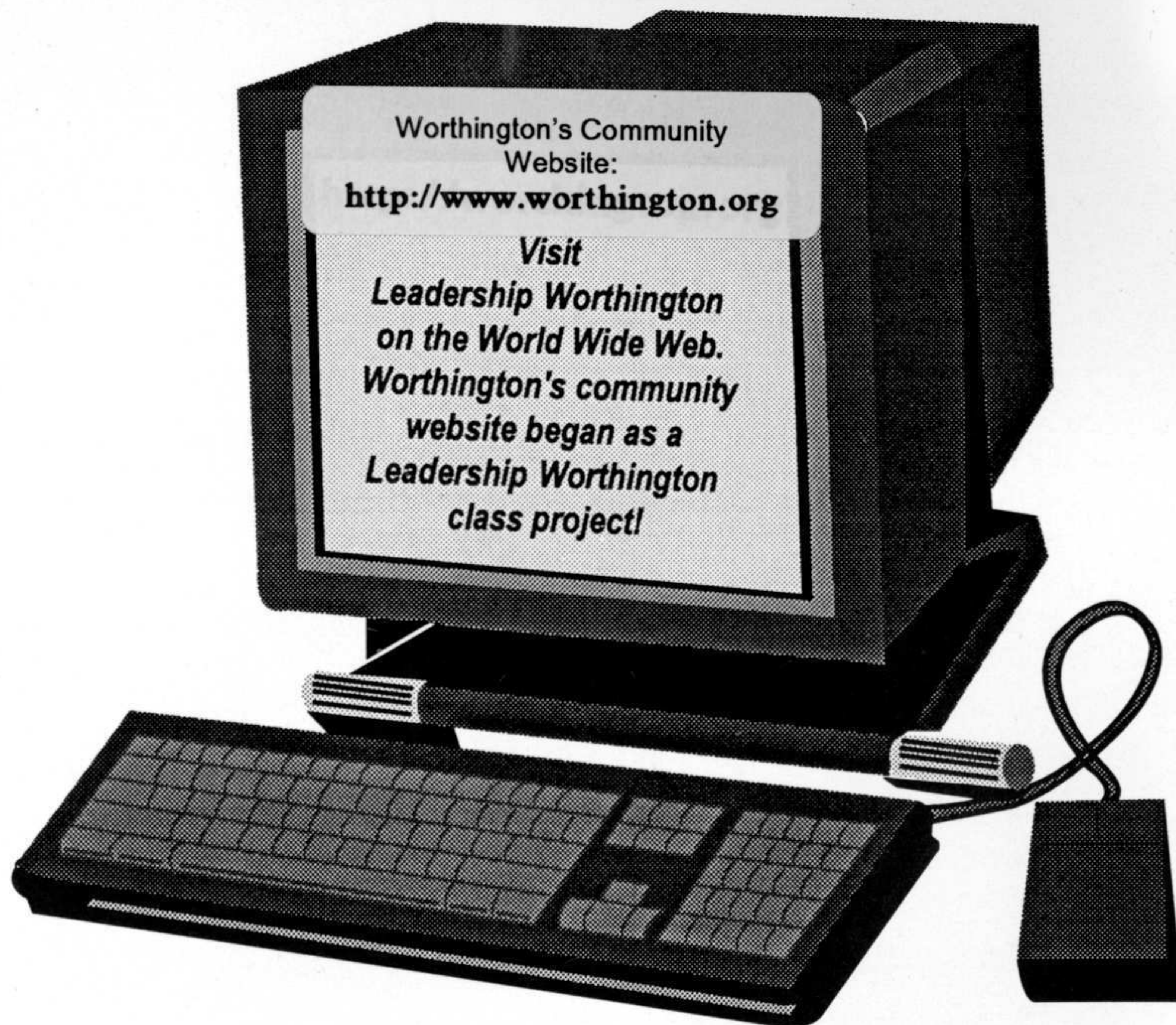

Leadership Worthington Begins A New Era

One of the Worthington area's lasting resources has been its residents. Regardless of cultural backgrounds, political ideologies or economic standing, the people here have a reputation for coming together in efforts to make the community a better place to live. One tool for such efforts has been Leadership Worthington. This intense nine-month program of personal and leadership development, now in its seventh year, has sent forth some 150 graduate "leaders" into the community. Through class projects completed by program participants, Leadership Worthington also has established several ongoing legacies, including annual Service Day, a community World Wide Web site, and the Leadership for a Lifetime Awards.

Before the beginning of the 1997 class year, Leadership Worthington's board of trustees lost a number of committed individuals who had served six years in founding and developing the program. Change was inevitable, and Leadership Worthington already has branched out in a number of new areas as the mid-point of 1997 approaches. They include the following:

- The board initiated the pilot for a Youth Leadership Development Program which has high hopes. Under the guidance of Leadership Worthington, the aim is to bring the same sort of personal and leader-

ship development to Worthington school district youth that adults currently are offered. A full-fledged program is being targeted for this fall and next spring.

- Leadership Worthington took over sponsorship of the Worthington Adult Spelling Bee this spring. Previously under the direction of the Worthington Educational Foundation, the Spelling Bee was believed to be a natural event for Leadership Worthington to direct. It also proved fruitful this first year, with 18 teams competing for spelling bragging rights in the community.
- Board members of Leadership Worthington voted to officially make a financial commitment to the program as well as a personal and time commitment, beginning in 1997.
- The board of trustees is planning a retreat in the fall to come together and work on Leadership Worthington's direction for the future.

Leadership Worthington's Proud Traditions

Just before graduation — typically, during National Volunteer Week — class members and other volunteers continue a Leadership Worthington tradition of service to the community through their participation in Service Day. Encouraged to join Leadership Worthington alumni and class members for a day of volunteer work, students and adults from service clubs and corporations pool their resources to clean and paint, assist elderly residents with household chores and errands, pick up trash, and tackle a variety of tasks to beautify the community and serve those in need. Volunteers collect pledges from family members, friends and co-workers.

Their collaborative efforts advance the mission of Leadership Worthington (*See page 14*), set by its founding board of trustees in fall 1989, when the program was launched as a cooperative venture of the Worthington Schools/Business/Community Partnership and the Worthington Area Chamber of Commerce. The current board has representation from each of the past Leadership Worthington classes, as well as leadership from the community at large.

Class projects also are completed and presented each spring. As part of their Leadership Worthington experience, program participants develop group projects which directly benefit the community. Many produce informative publications, examine community problems, or launch ongoing programs. Service Day began as a class project, as did the Leadership for a Lifetime Awards, which annually recognize two adults, a senior high student, a middle school student and an elementary school student for exemplary community, school and organizational leadership. Each honoree's name is engraved in a brick which paves the walkway to Worthington's Municipal Building, giving lasting recognition to special individuals who are committed to a lifetime of leadership.

The Program: Honing Personal & Partnership Skills

Coordinating the Leadership Worthington program and its related activities is Executive Director Judy Barnhart, a professional consultant experienced in training and development, fund raising and organizational management. Judy represents Leadership Worthington on the Ohio Association of Community Leadership and facilitates our partnership with other community organizations.
