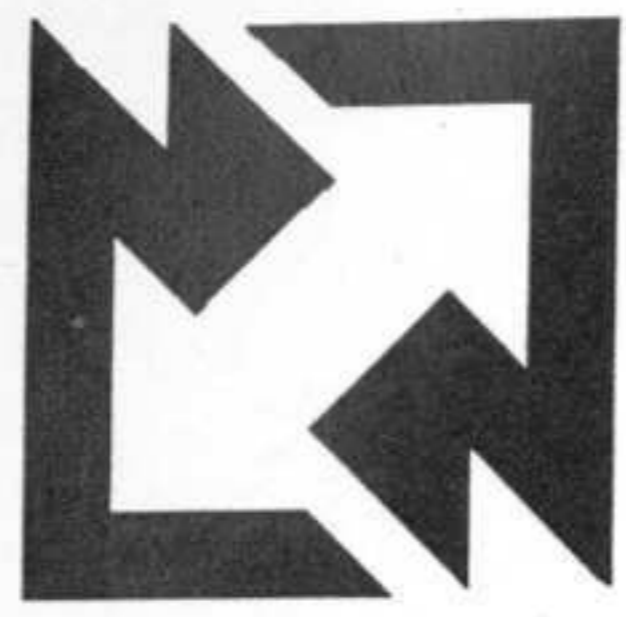

Lighting the Way: Leadership Worthington Graduates

Like the familiar, flower-adorned lamppost which decorates each juncture of Worthington's streetscape, Leadership Worthington has become a signature tradition of Worthington life. Proudly sporting American flags as "everyday dress" since Sept. 11, the lampposts are a reminder of our unity and strength under challenge — some of the same principles espoused by the more than 250 graduates of the Leadership Worthington program since its development late in 1989.



Beginning their program in the shadow of that flag just a few days after the Sept. 11 tragedies, the 12th class of Leadership Worthington took up the yoke of responsible citizenship in somber times. Class projects, targeted at enlivening local economic development and celebrating our American heritage in the upcoming Worthington Bicentennial, reflect those times and the concerns of our community. Fittingly, the Leadership Worthington program is steeped in the American traditions of caring for and helping one another, collectively building a civil society, and sharing in the preservation of families, neighborhoods, communities and nations.

"Leadership Worthington is an organization of individuals rising above differences and united under common dreams and visions of a better Worthington community," said Judy Barnhart, former executive director of Leadership Worthington, who retired in April 2002 after eight years of overseeing the program. During her tenure, Barnhart saw the organization grow from a fledgling adult program into a multigenerational leadership program with a solid financial base, offering the respected adult program, two youth programs and a community service component.

As Leadership Worthington began its 12th year, participants again found ways to connect civic-minded Americans in pursuit of great goals. Average Americans with big ideas are getting things done in Worthington, strengthening our community, and building the ethic of service and volunteering. Our motto, "People

Make the Difference," is as appropriate today as it was when the first class convened in Fall 1990.

A strong board of trustees, composed of Leadership Worthington graduates and other community and business leaders, has responsibilities structured along three vision areas: relationships (recruitment, recognition, public relations and alumni), finance (development, Adult Spelling Bee and Service Day), and programs (adult, Leadership Tomorrow for high school students and Leadership Plus for middle school students).

Modeling problem-solving to create more innovative strategies for outreach, trustees recently have engaged greater interest and support from businesses and other organizations within the community by forging new partnerships and collaborative networks.

About the Leadership Worthington Program

Fostering effective young leaders for the new millennium, Leadership Tomorrow, the teen component of Leadership Worthington, offers six sessions to high school students in a broad array of leadership skills and ways to apply their new learning in the community and at their schools. Young participants take up to 25 hours of intensive, interactive activities and exercises to illustrate basic leadership principles. More than 220 graduates of Leadership Tomorrow have been inspired to take solution-learning into their school community. Service learning projects have included work with the Homeless Families Foundation, Wheelchair Basketball, Capital Area Humane Society, Mid-Ohio FoodBank and the Interfaith Hospitality Network. The Youth Celebration Banquet held in April celebrates the accomplishments of youth leaders and their parents.

Leadership Plus, a middle school program, expanded to three schools this year. Five summer sessions and five mentoring sessions during the academic year prepare these young people for school leadership and service involvement.

Signs of Leadership Worthington can be seen throughout our community. Our annual communitywide Service Day each May continues to assist senior citizens and community organizations with property clean-up. Leadership for a Lifetime Awards and the Ohio Association for Community Leadership Awards celebrate leadership success by accomplished citizens. The Adult Spelling Bee provides a forum for leadership in literacy and forges community partnerships.

Meanwhile, a corps of caring citizens, armed with problem-solving, networking and mentoring skills from their Leadership Worthington participation, provides an arsenal of leadership to local schools and libraries, city commissions and service, cultural and civic clubs. Like the signature Worthington lamp-posts, these leaders are welcoming, strong influences, brightening every corner of our community. ↗

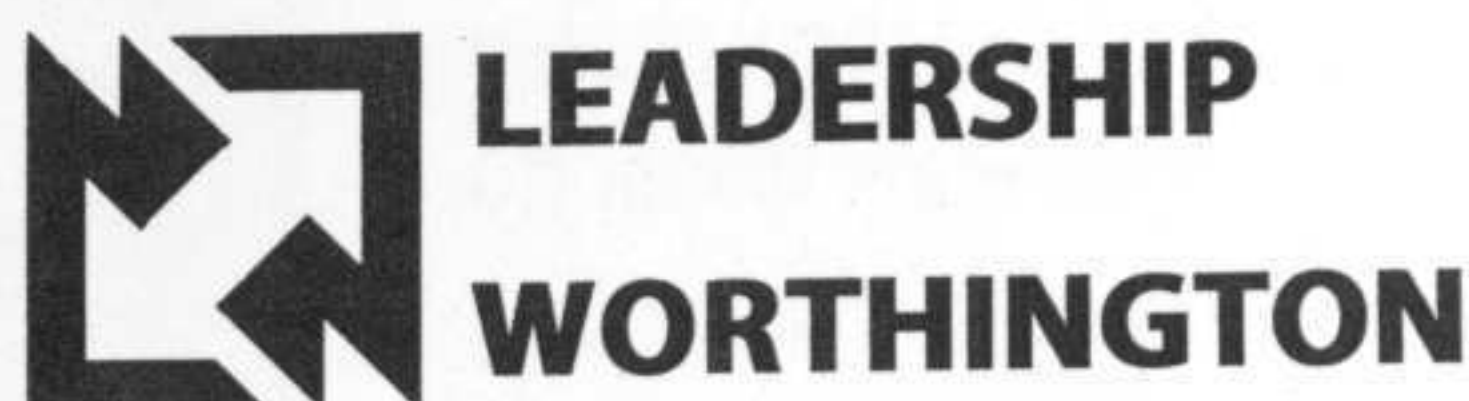
About the Program & Our Executive Director

Leadership Worthington welcomed a talented new leader of its own in Spring 2002. Coordinating the program and its related activities is Executive Director Judith Harvey, Ph.D., who has served the non-profit community for more than 20 years in higher education, government, health and human services. She has been an ombudsman, fund raiser, government administrator and executive director of a community health care agency, directing multi-city fund-raising campaigns and holding leadership positions in statewide board and professional organizations.

In her new role she oversees the Leadership Worthington program in which participants attend a series of carefully designed classes which address such topics as:



- ***personal leadership skill development; including self-assessments, effective small group communication, public speaking and team-building;***
- ***Worthington history and cultural heritage;***
- ***municipal structure and issues;***
- ***the Worthington public school system;***
- ***human services and community volunteerism;***
- ***multicultural issues; and***
- ***the business community.***

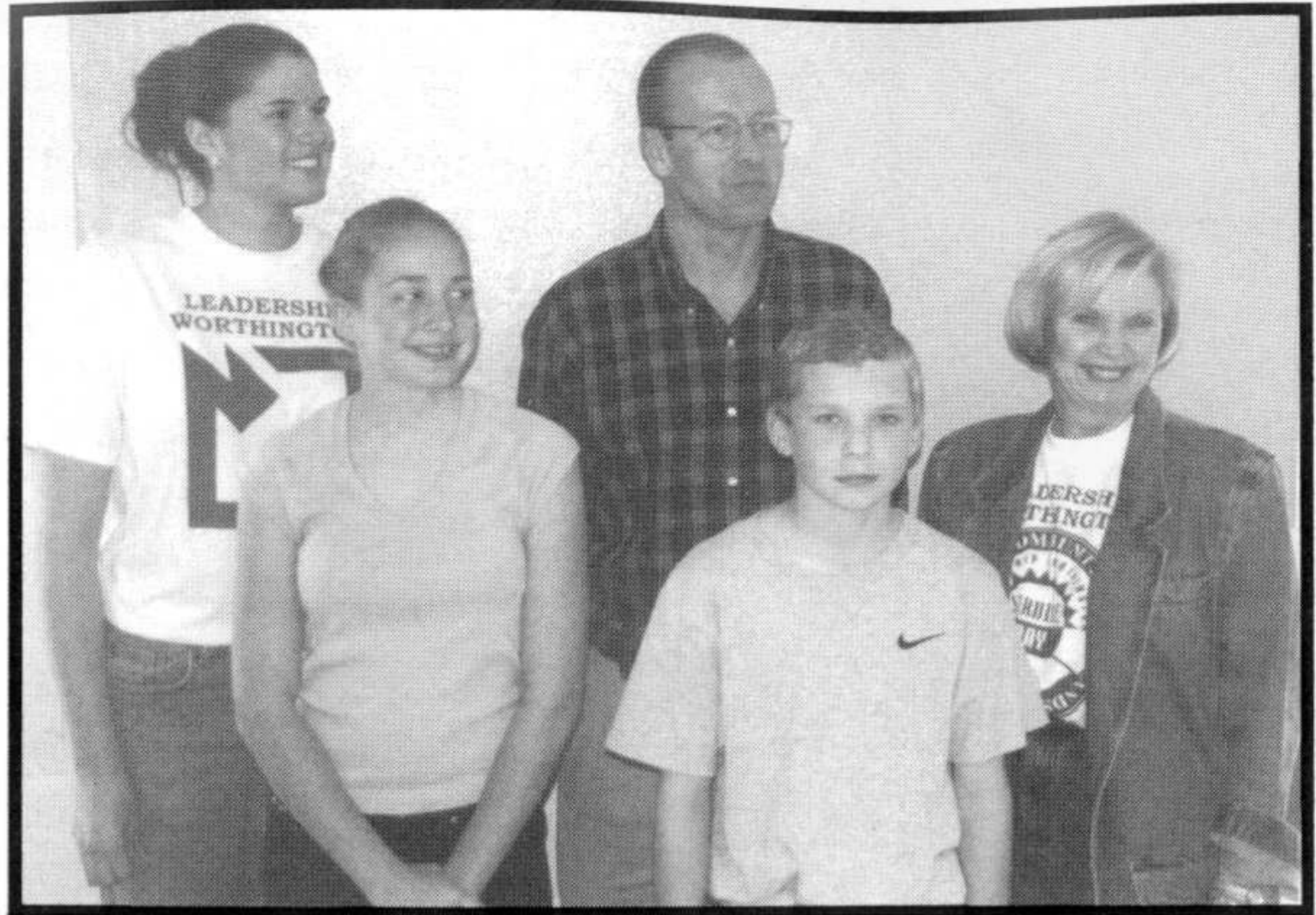

Leadership for a Lifetime Award Winners

Through the annual Leadership for a Lifetime Awards, which began as a Leadership Worthington class project, the Worthington community annually recognizes two adults, a senior high student, a middle school student and an elementary school student for exemplary community, school and organizational leadership.

The honorees are chosen by a selection committee of Leadership Worthington alumni and previous recipients which carefully screens candidates who have been nominated by residents and business leaders in the Worthington community.

Each honoree's name is engraved in a brick which paves the walkway to the municipal building, giving lasting recognition to special individuals who are committed to a lifetime of leadership.
