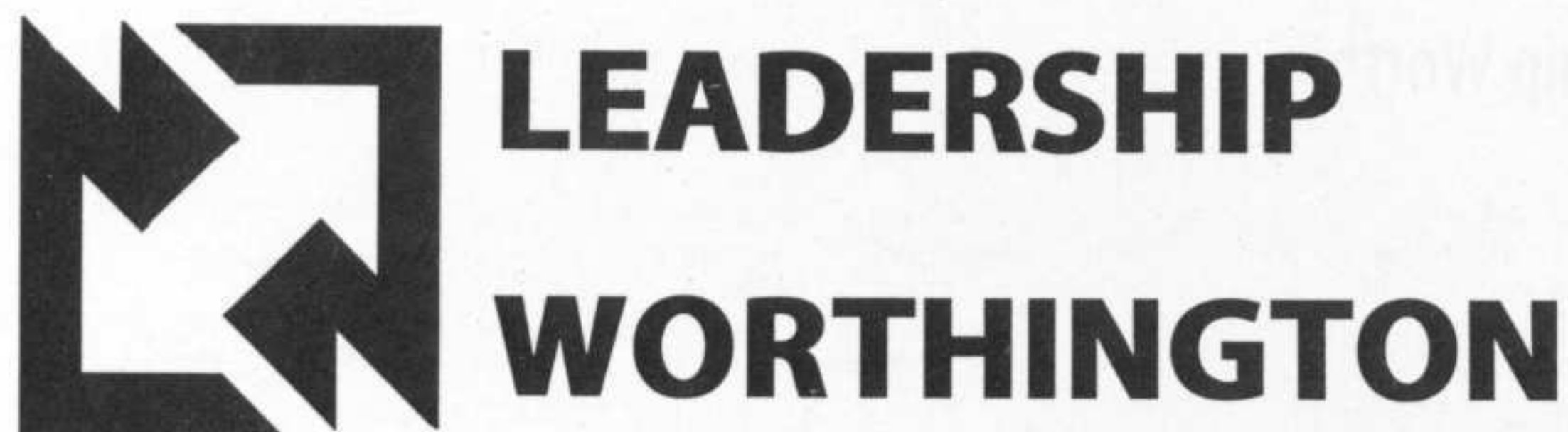

In 2003, Worthington celebrated 200 years of history with a Bicentennial Heritage Ball, a wagon train tracing the Connecticut pioneers' route from the Ohio border to Worthington, an ox roast, and numerous other celebrations honoring our past. Leadership Worthington participated fully in these activities through its many volunteers. We have no doubt that every Bicentennial activity and task force included some Leadership Worthington graduates. Other highlights of our past year included:

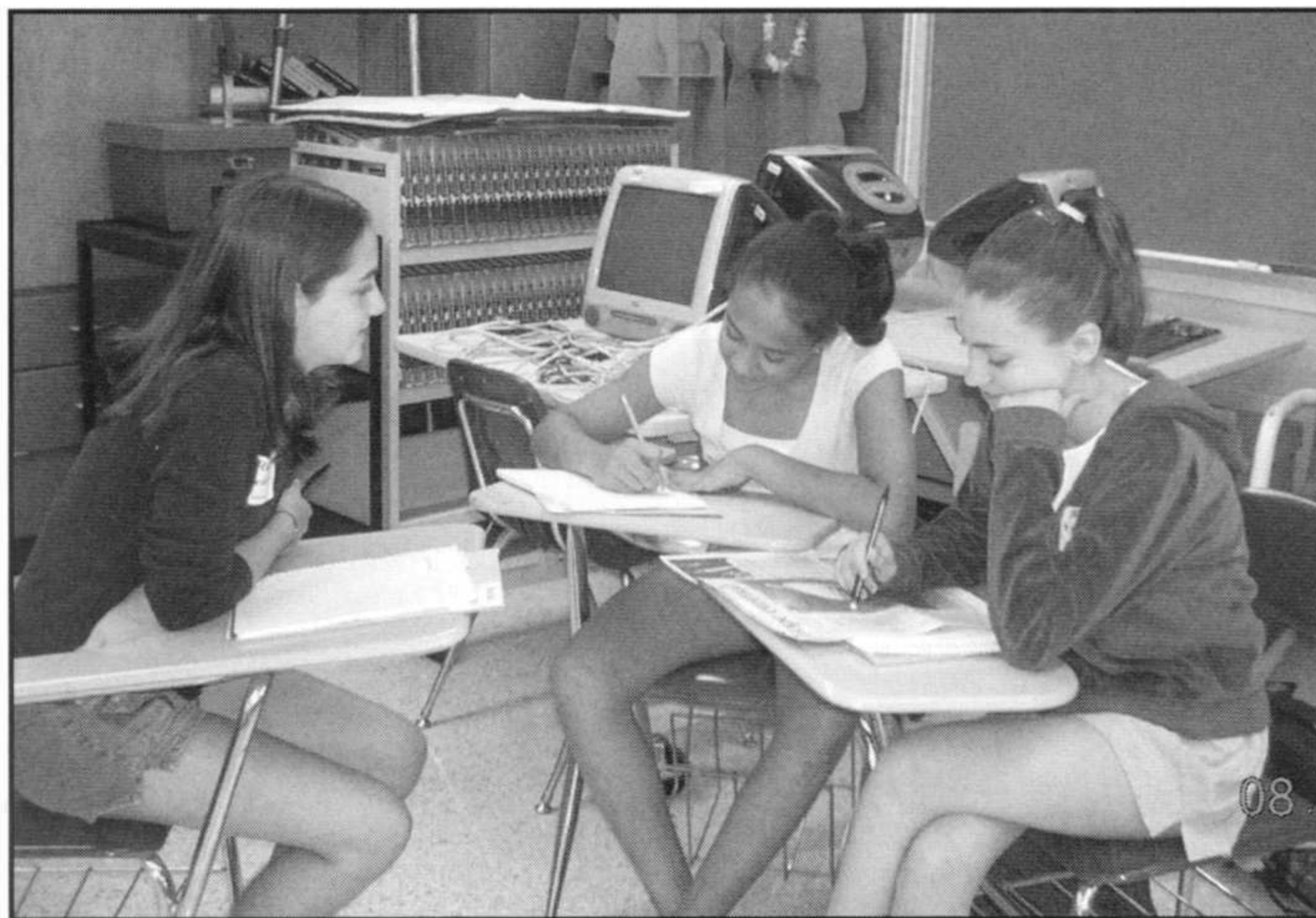


✓ Hiring a part-time youth programs coordinator.

Amy Weinsz, a 2002 Leadership Worthington graduate who expressed interest in working with youth, now coordinates both the Leadership Tomorrow (high school) and Leadership Plus (middle school) programs. "Amy is a go-getter whose enthusiastic approach to young people has paid off with great success," according to Joan Bird and Steve Weislogel, board member volunteers who work closely with Amy to provide quality programs.

✓ Launching "Start Something/Leadership Plus."

Enhancing the Leadership Plus program for middle school students (*pictured below*) was imperative if this program is to remain current and non-redundant in the community. Rising to the challenge, board member Mary Greenlee partnered with Amy Weinsz to initiate this effort under the auspices of the Tiger Woods Foundation. Mary's tireless efforts helped to move these



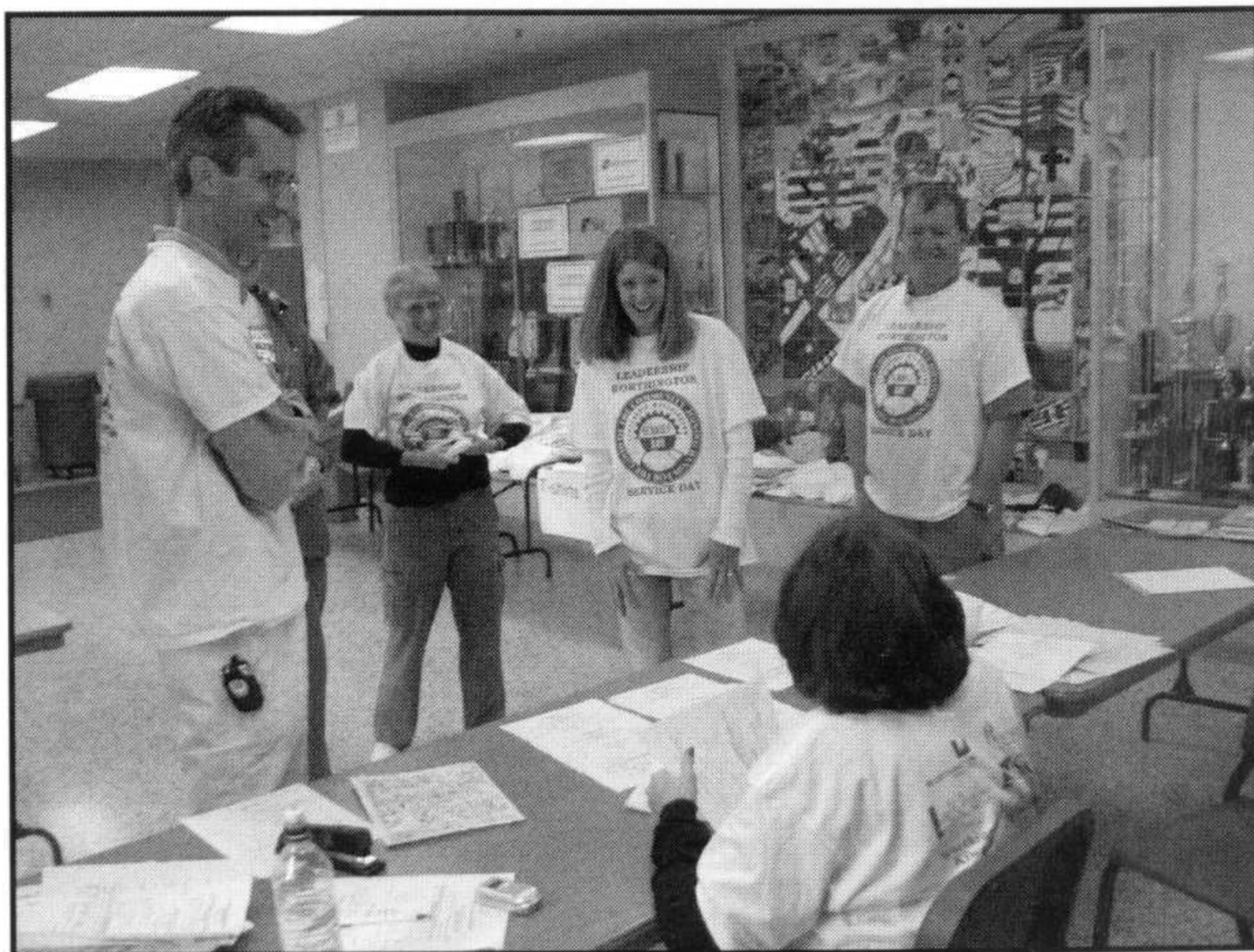
improvements forward, with the collaboration of several high school students who agreed to serve as mentors for the middle school students.

About the Leadership Worthington Program

✓ Collaborating more visibly with other local organizations.

Leadership Worthington pursued partnerships with other local organizations, such as the Junior League, the Central Ohio Better Business Bureau (BBB) and the Worthington Area Chamber of Commerce, to bring informative sessions of interest to the community: *A Leadership Character Workshop/Luncheon*, with Partners for Citizenship & Character, the Chamber and the BBB, and *Taking Control of Your Life*, with Donna Glanzman, were two examples.

✓ Conducting our 10th annual Service Day.

Helping hands from Leadership Worthington volunteers on Service Day in May resulted in more than 90 senior citizens receiving assistance from nearly as many volunteers.

✓ Promoting Leadership Worthington at informational lunches.

In 2003, Leadership Worthington held informational lunches for individuals wishing to know more about or become involved in Leadership Worthington. Three such lunches were held for a total of 35 to 40 interested persons.

✓ Holding our first Annual Meeting as a separate event.

Our very first Annual Meeting was held as a separate event to which friends and family were invited, along with alumni and class members.

✓ Creating the Leadership Network.

The Leadership Network is an informally structured organization of Leadership Worthington alumni and friends who commit to one volunteer activity per year on behalf of the community. The intent is to extend the capacity of our board so that the Leadership Worthington mission can be achieved throughout the city.

Judy Harvey completed her first year as Leadership Worthington's executive director during 2003. Accomplishments included new collaborative ventures with local civic organizations and adjustments in staffing assignments to utilize skills more effectively. "The

Leadership for a Lifetime Award Winners

The honorees are chosen by a selection committee of Leadership Worthington alumni and previous recipients which carefully screens candidates who have been nominated by residents and business leaders in the Worthington community.

Each honoree's name is engraved in a brick which paves the walkway to the municipal building, giving lasting recognition to special individuals who are committed to a lifetime of leadership.
