The original Commencement play, DEEP IN OUR HEARTS, was planned, written, and revised by the eighty-six students of Mr. Rousculp's three senior English classes. Building upon the idea of a school, eleven writing groups--each of them heterogeneous in its talents--submitted complete manuscripts containing dialogue, stage directions, song parodies and suggestions, scale drawings, and property lists. The three most effective of these group scripts provided the basis for the final product. Various ideas and lines were incorporated from others of the manuscripts, and everybody participated in the final revision. DEEP IN OUR HEARTS truly belongs to the Class of '58.
