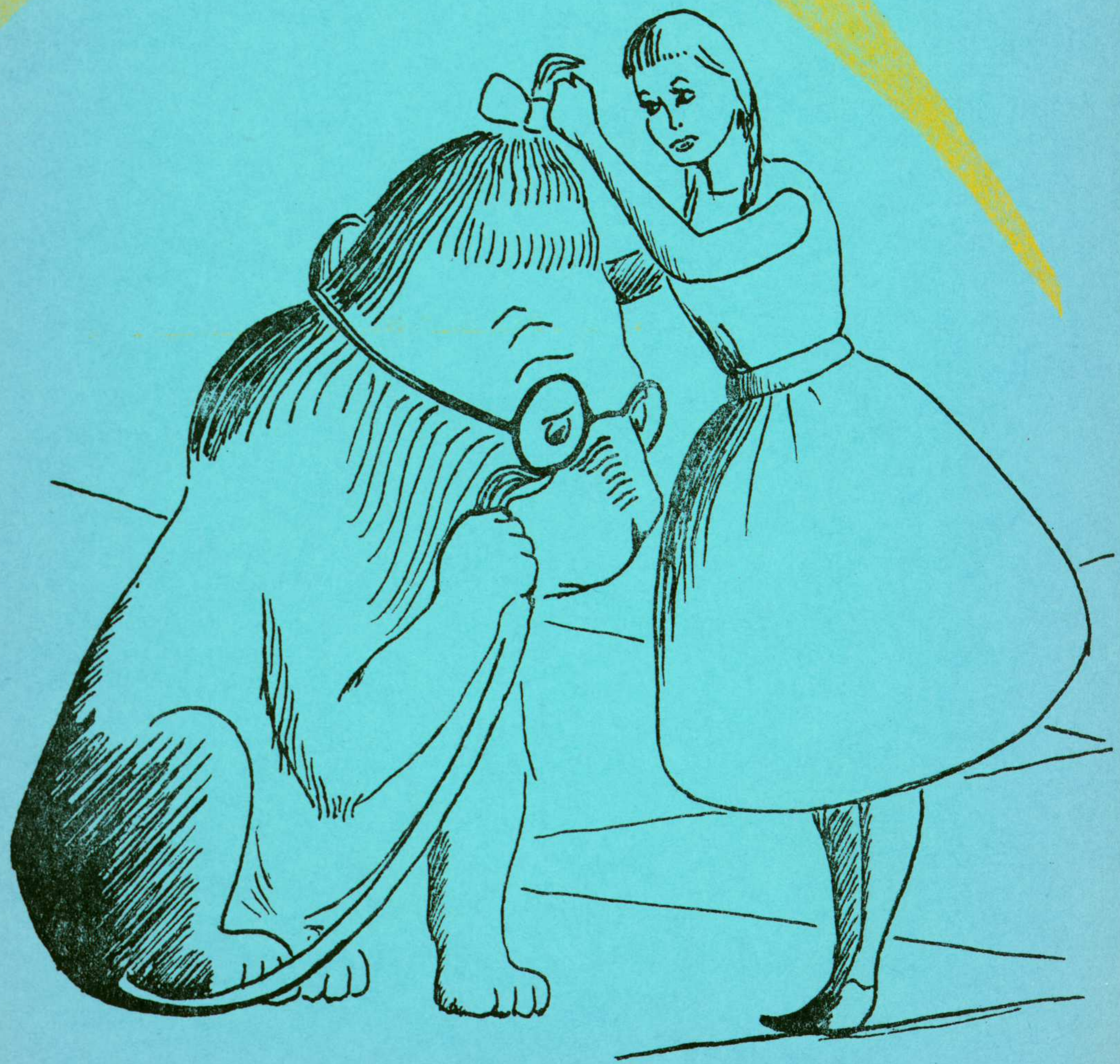

The original Commencement play, THE QUEST, was planned, written, and revised by the eighty-three students of Mr. Rousculp's three English IV classes. Building upon the idea of the graduates' search for happiness, eight writing groups--each of them heterogeneous in its talents--submitted complete manuscripts containing dialogue, stage directions, song parodies and suggestions, scale drawings, and property lists. All eight manuscripts contributed portions to the final hybrid manuscript, with the teacher organizing and providing continuity, and everybody participating in the final revision. THE QUEST truly belongs to the Class of '59.

At a time when teachers are always busily bringing their individual programs to a close, Miss Ruth Pierce generously provided her creative talent and invaluable assistance in arranging the music and in building, in less than three weeks, a senior chorus. The collective "thank you" of the class and the production staff can hardly express our appreciation for all this and for the person that she is.
