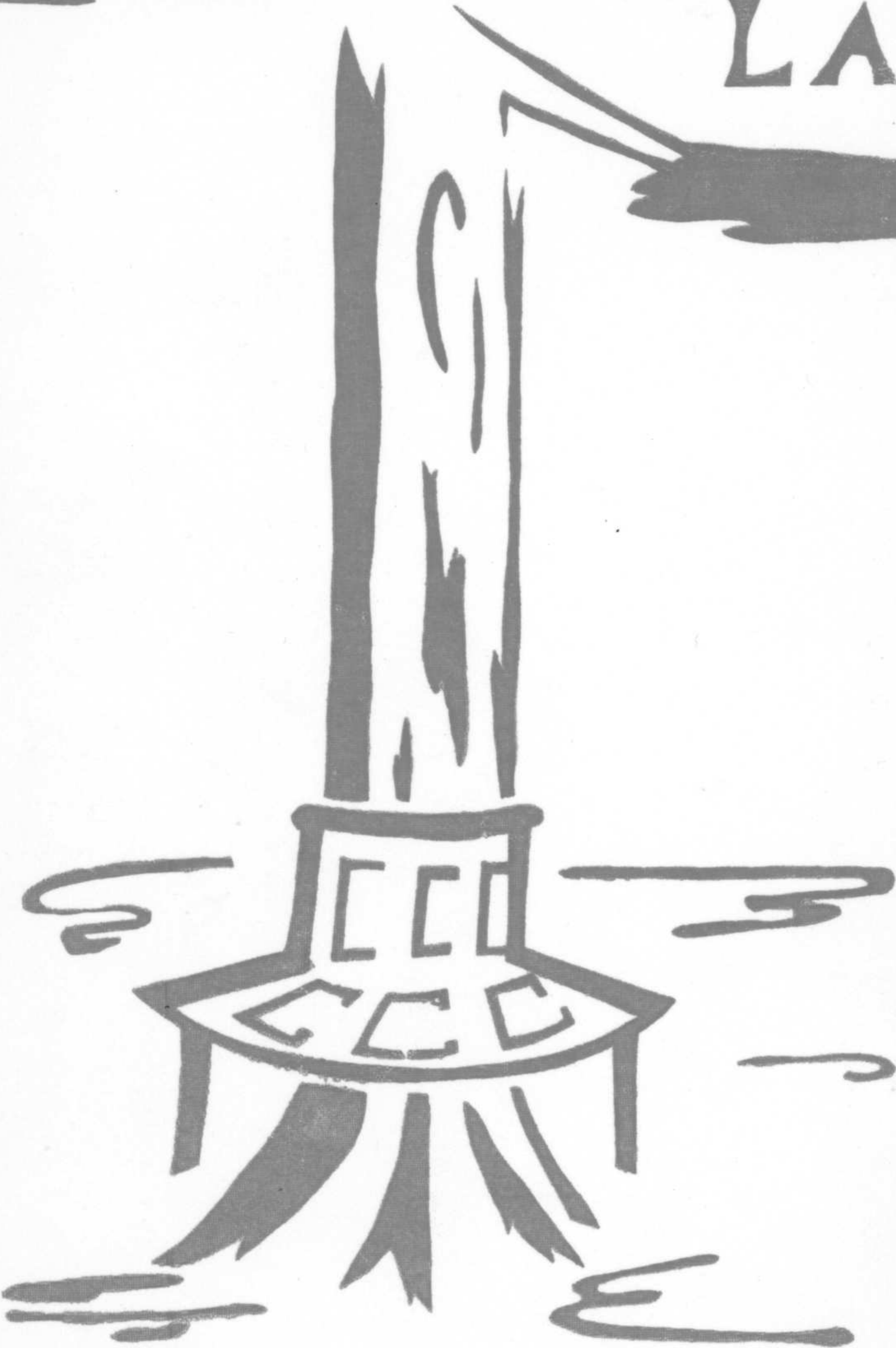

The original Commencement play, 57 LEPRECHAUN LANE, was planned, written, and revised by the eighty students of Mr. Rousculp's three senior English classes. Building upon the idea of a tree, ten writing groups -- each of them homogeneous in its talents -- submitted complete manuscripts containing dialogue, stage directions, song parodies and suggestions, scale drawings, and property lists. The most inventive of these groups created J. Fred Brownie, the basic teen-ager situations, and a large portion of the dialogue in the final product. Various ideas and lines were incorporated from others of the manuscripts, and everybody participated in the final revision. 57 LEPRECHAUN LANE truly belongs to the Class of '57.

At a time when teachers are always busily bringing their individual programs to a close, Miss Ruth Pierce provided her creative talent and invaluable assistance in building, in less than three weeks, a senior chorus. The collective "thank you" of the class and the production staff can hardly express our appreciation for all this and for the person that she is.
