The original Commencement play, CAST THE FIRST STONE, was planned, written, and revised by the students of Mr. Rousculp's four English IV classes. Aiming at a serio-comic self-evaluation in a trial by jury, ten writing groups--each of them heterogeneous in its talents--submitted complete manuscripts containing dialogue, stage directions, song parodies and suggestions, scale drawings, and property lists. All ten manuscripts contributed portions to the final hybrid manuscript, with the teacher organizing and providing continuity. CAST THE FIRST STONE truly belongs to the Class of 1960.
