CHARLES E. JEFFERSON AWARDS

Charles E. Jefferson, a graduate of Ohio Wesleyan University, served as teacher and superintendent in the Worthington Public Schools from 1882 until 1884. After leaving Worthington, Dr. Jefferson entered the ministry, in which profession he remained until his retirement.

The Board of Education received a gift of \$5,000 in 1941 to be invested. The interest from this investment was to go annually to the two members of the Senior Class of the Worthington High School who have maintained the highest averages in their studies for the four years of high school.

The award was first given in 1942, and to date fifty-two students have received this honor.
