in rent Lewis at par for goods
I am doing very well in that business
I received from James Owens one
hundred Dollars last fall will expect
you to pay your self for your trouble
the balance if any if you can send
By some that may be coming out
to this place I will thank God for the
venture James Owens will come out
this fall we expect a messenger to
assist in our return But I did as much
for him here I did not expect he would
charge me for his services

get it out of him if you can
the rest that you state I will leave
it all to your own Judgment
I sent a ten dollar note back to
winegardner that was not good
in a letter requesting him to
pay it to you or send to ones I have
had no account of if you should see
him put him in mind of it
we live on the nation road in
the prairie have 50 acres under
good price & 40 brood in corn
Bilt a house 16 by 7 1/2 feet a stable 40 by 30
we are well satisfied with our
exchange there is a abundance
of land to enter no more at present
