This article of Agreement made and entered
into this third (3^d) day of April A.D. 1869
at the City of Columbus Ga between Orange Johnson
H. Sessions and J. A. Jeffery, all of the City of
Columbus Ga. Witnesses that the above mentioned
parties whose names and amounts attached, have this
day formed a Partnership for the purpose of
doing a General Banking business in the City of
Columbus Ga. Now at 100 North High St. in
"Columbus Block" under the firm and style of
Commercial Bank

The two first mentioned parties above agree to
pay into the Bank as Capital Stock as following viz
Orange Johnson Twelve thousand five hundred dollars \$12,500
H. Sessions Twelve thousand five hundred dollars \$12,500
Twenty five thousand dollars \$25,000
to be paid in at once,
the remainder to be paid in as convenient, not to
exceed one year from date,

J. A. Jeffery agrees to devote his whole time and
attention (in connection with Messrs Johnson and
Sessions) to the management of the business,
