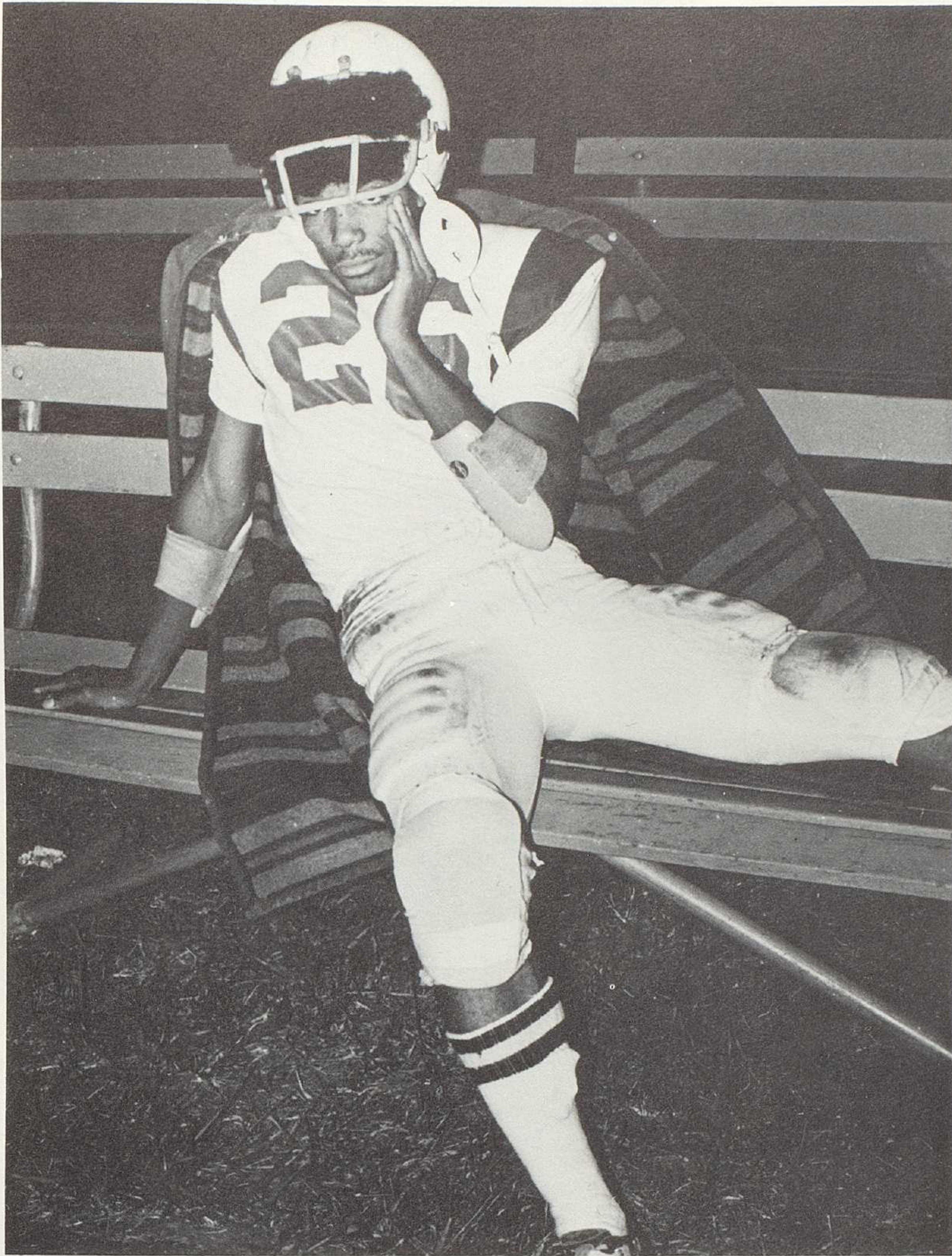
## Homecoming—the annual festival of chicken wire and tissue paper

## Sōkēr— a recently- discovered side-kick of WHS

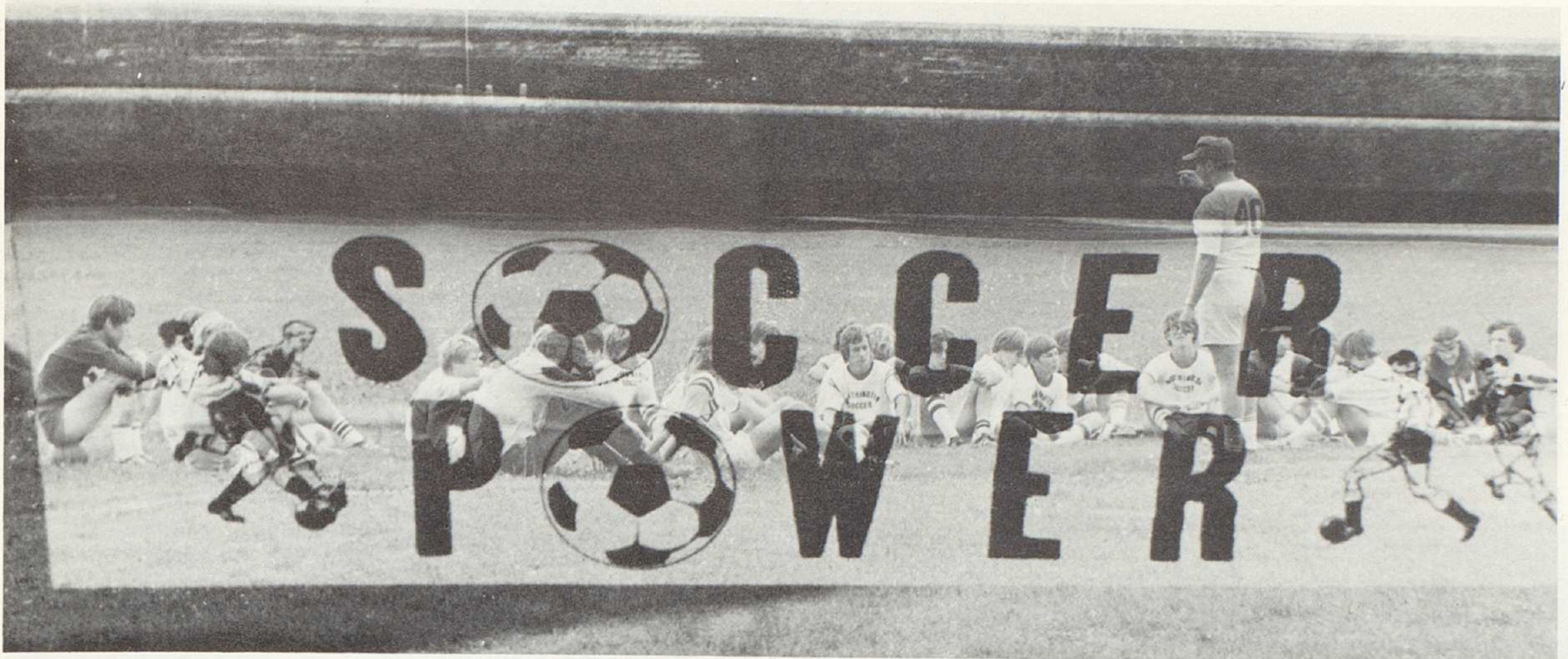

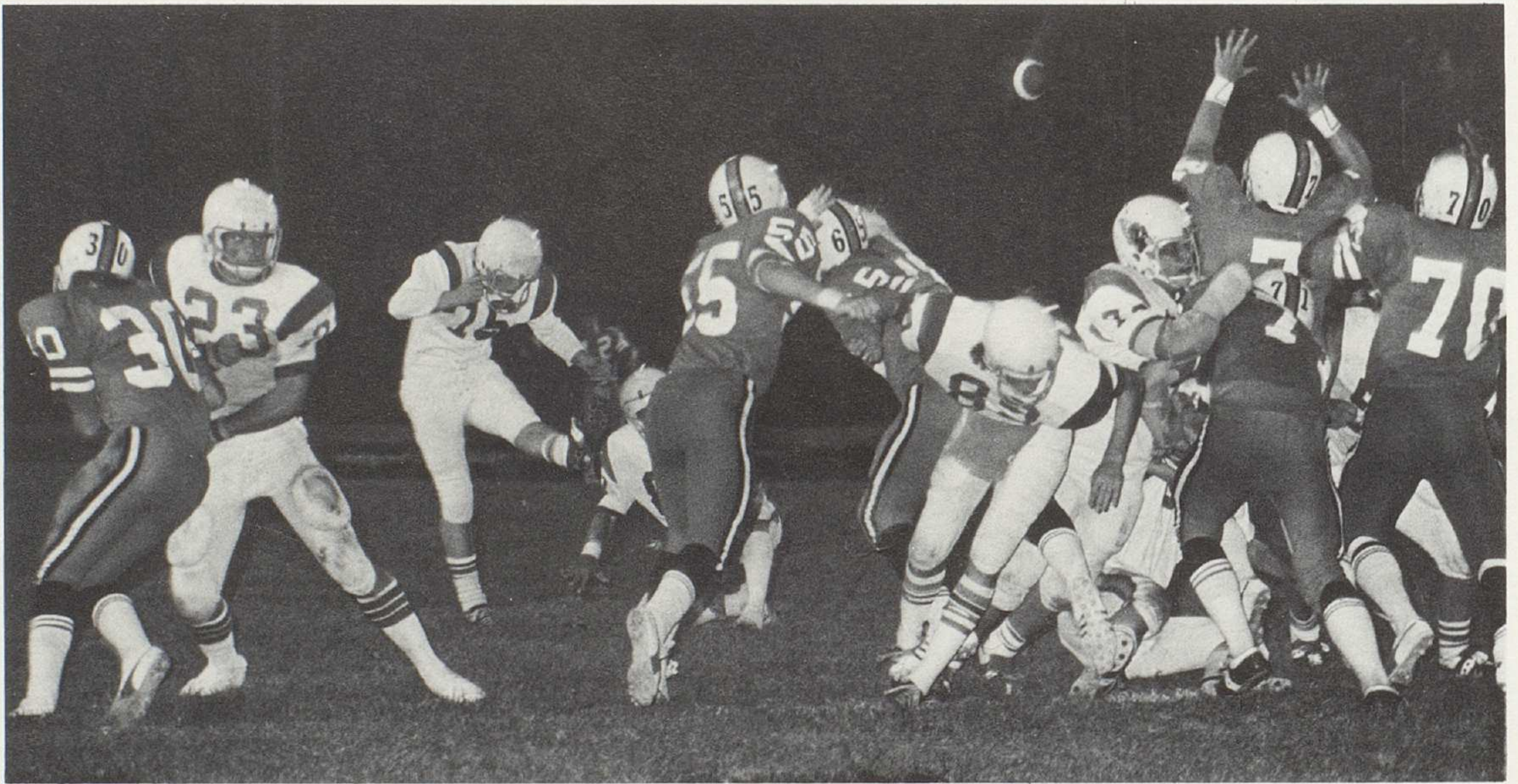
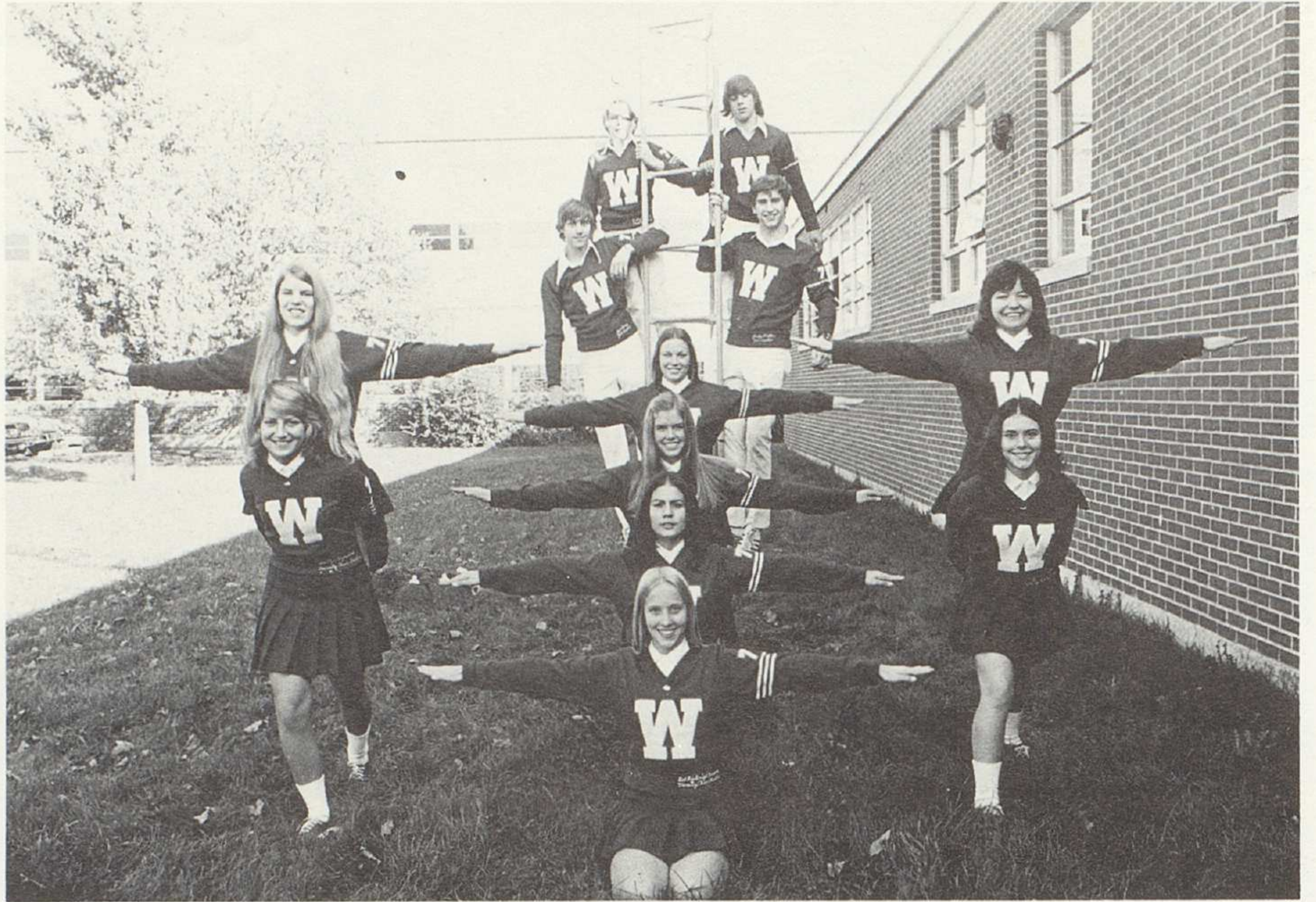


**Fūtbāl**—*the common meeting place for Friday night fans*

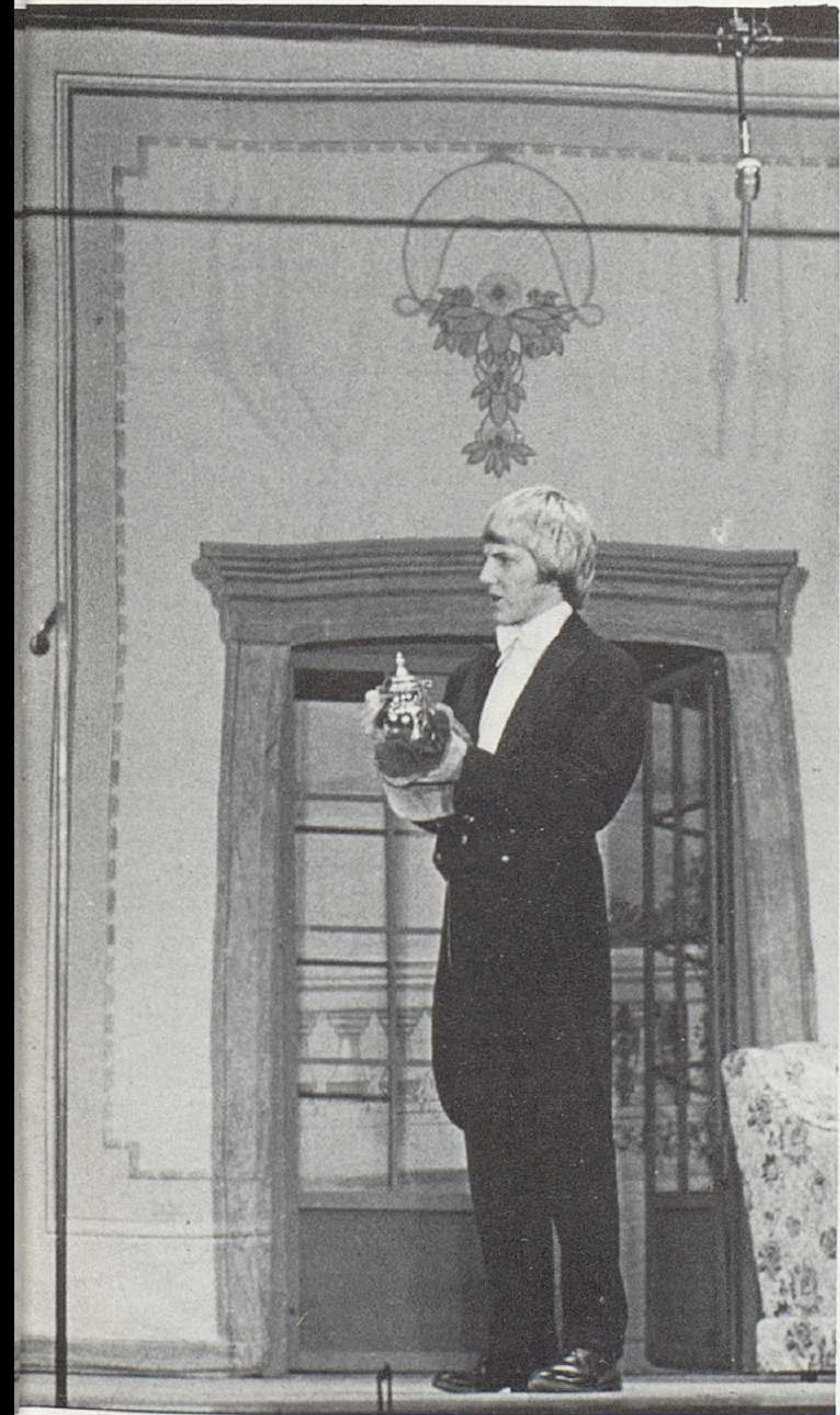






## Operedã—*musical moments*

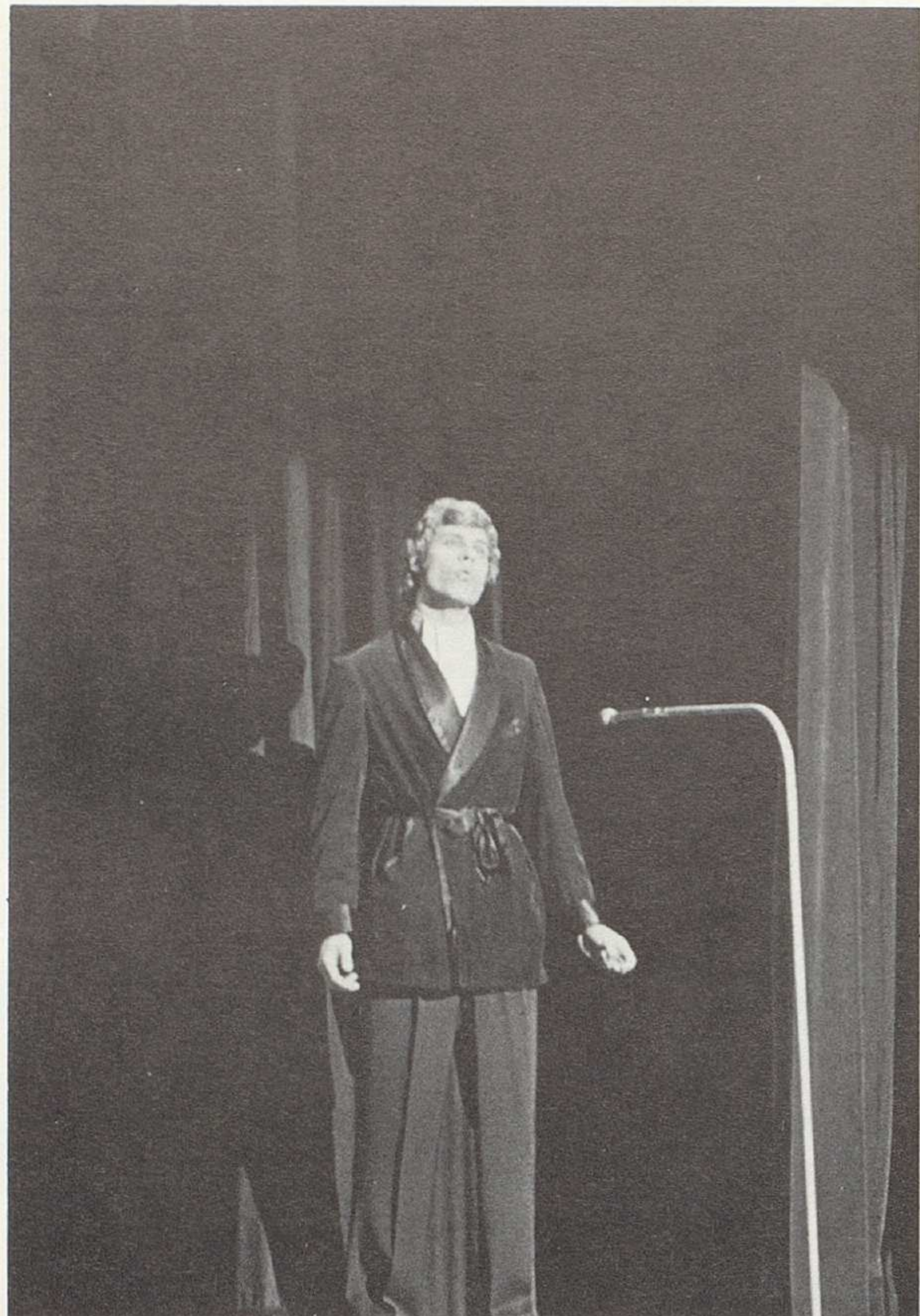

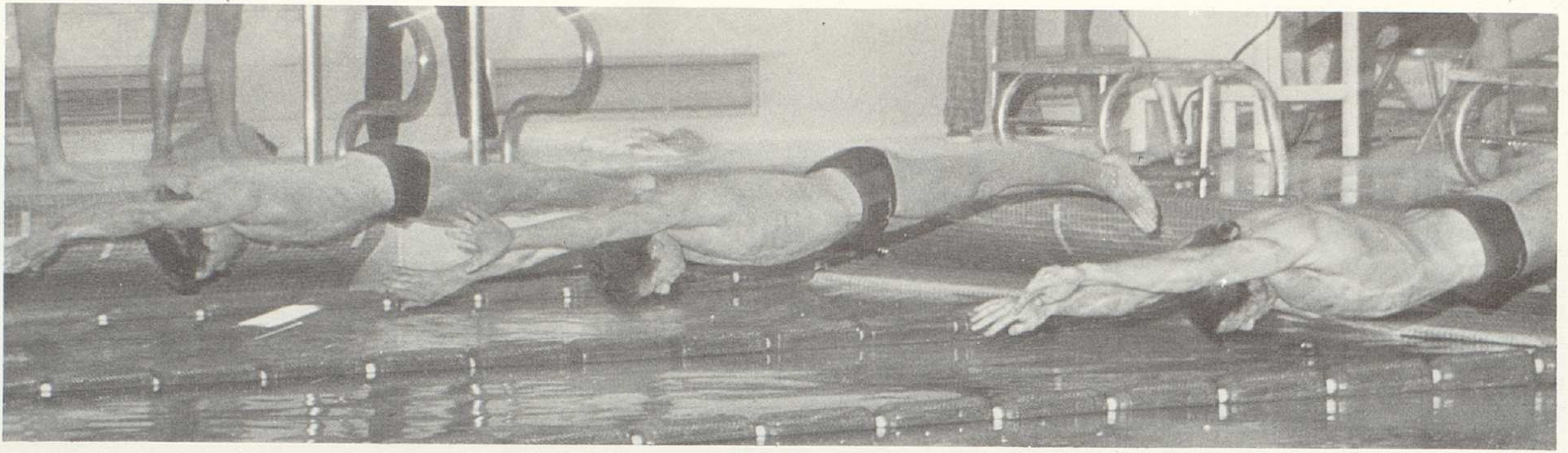




### **(W)restling**— *particularly “Pin Point People”*

## The Chil'drinz Plā— a "fantastic" show

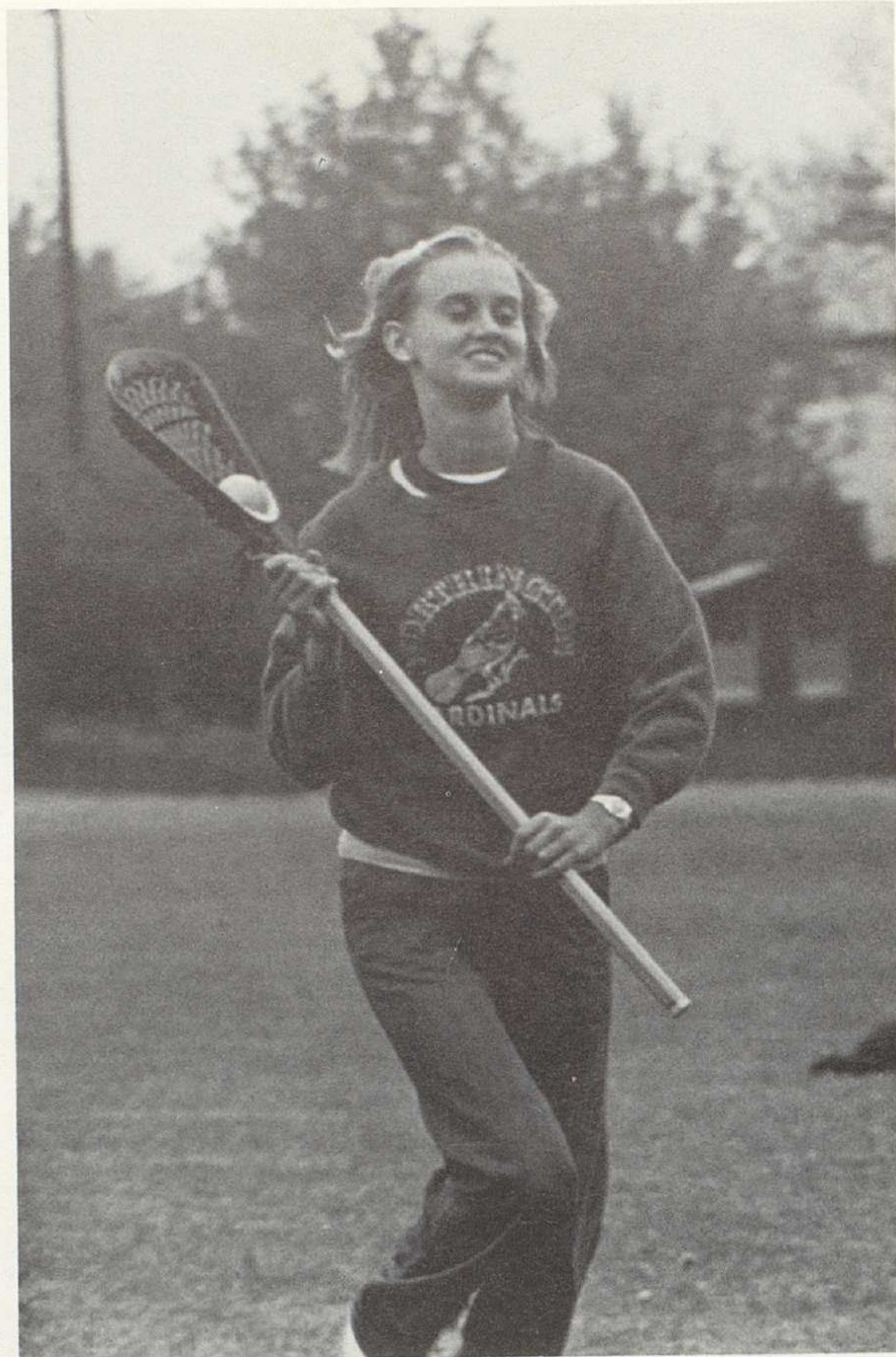

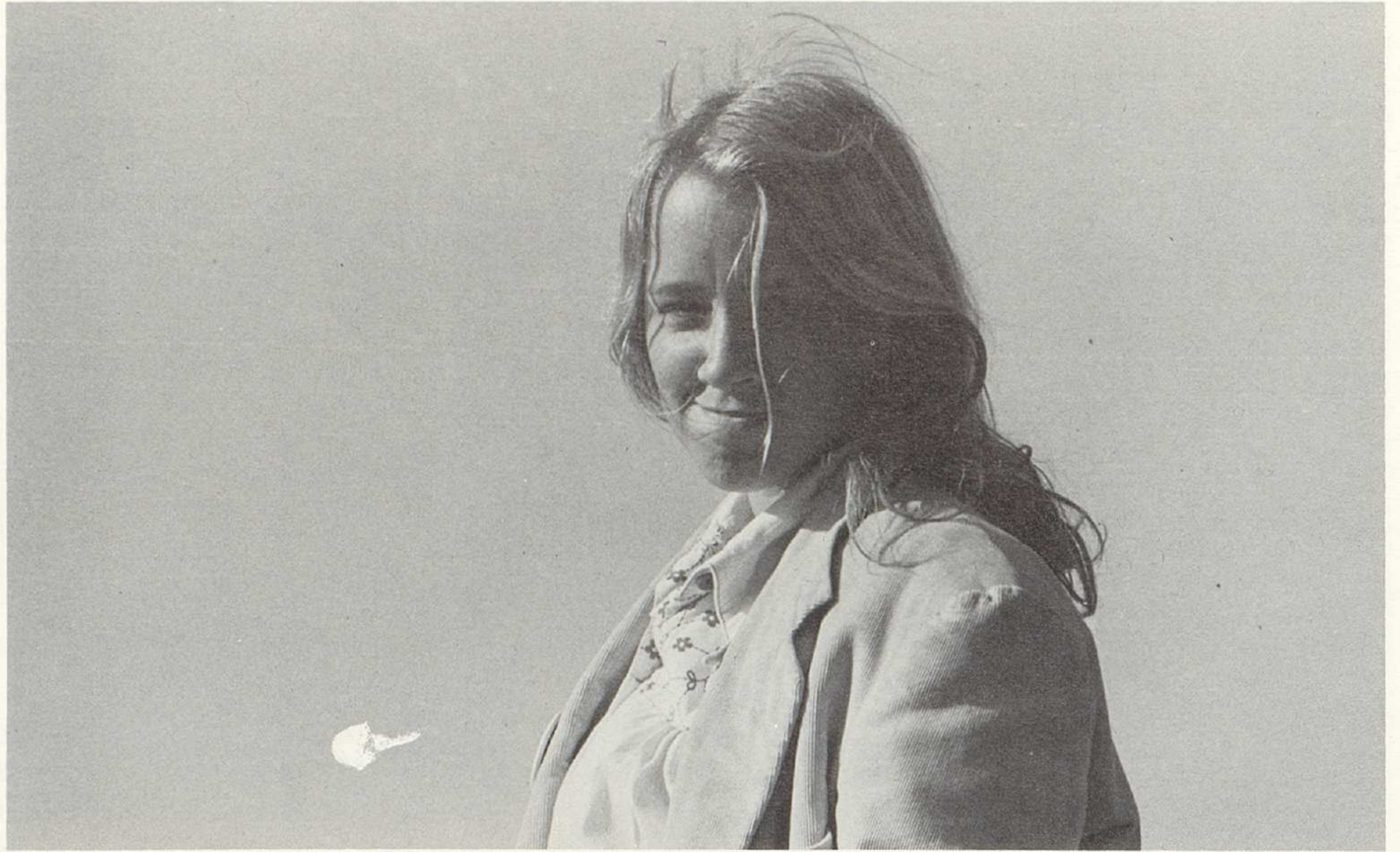


## The Class of '76

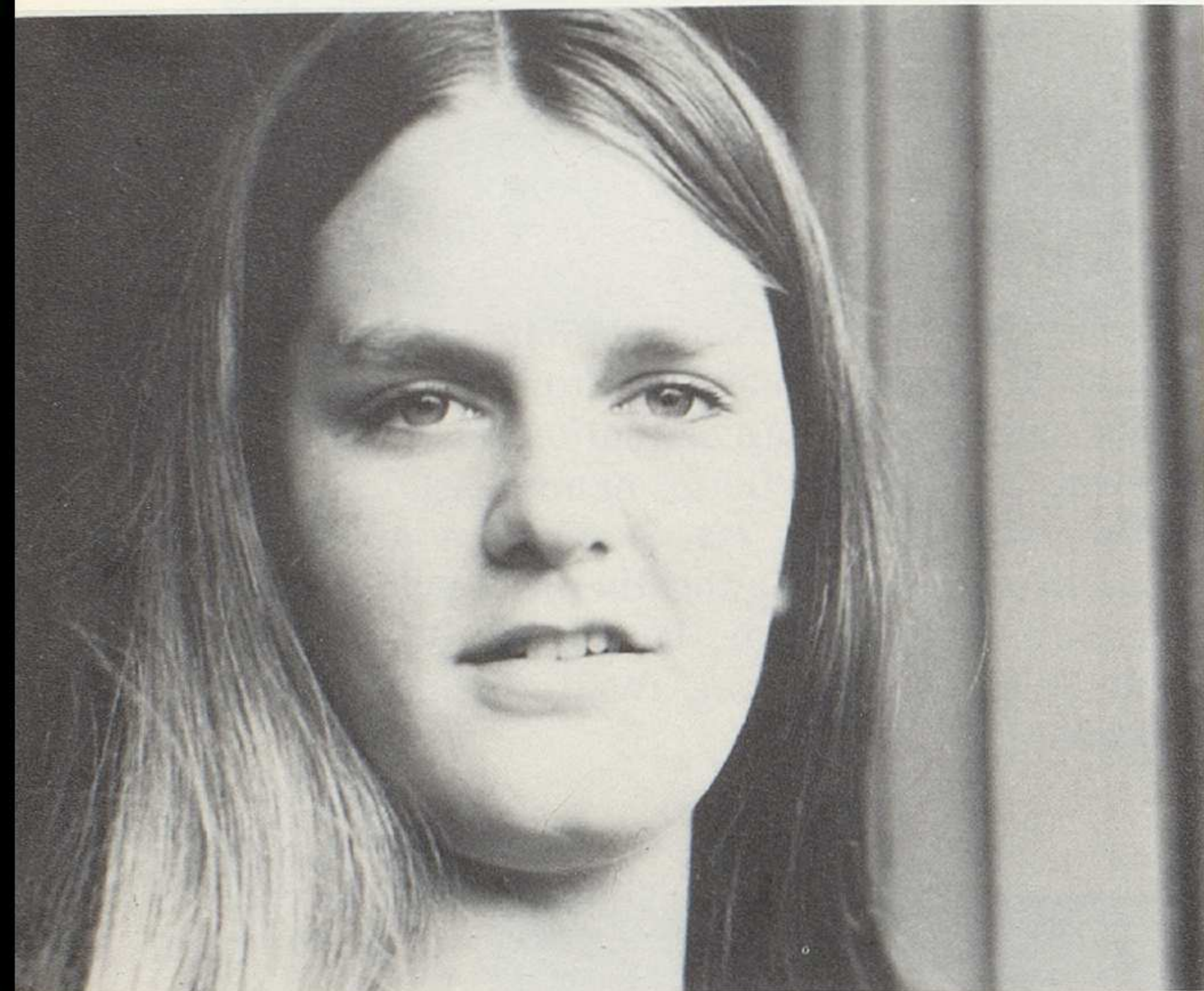
## The Class of '74

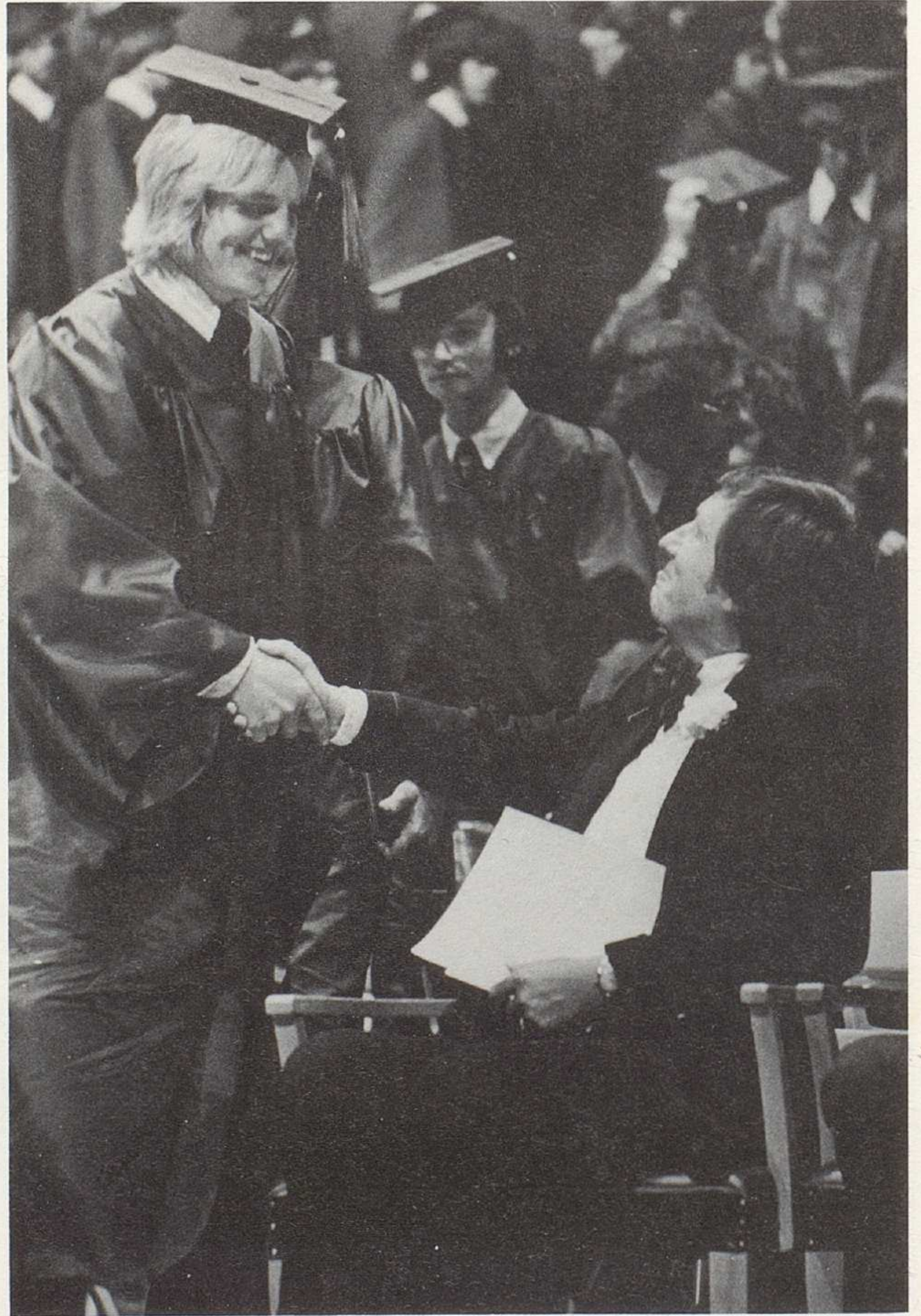


## Sēn'yer Rekigníshun Asemblē— *graduate goodbyes*

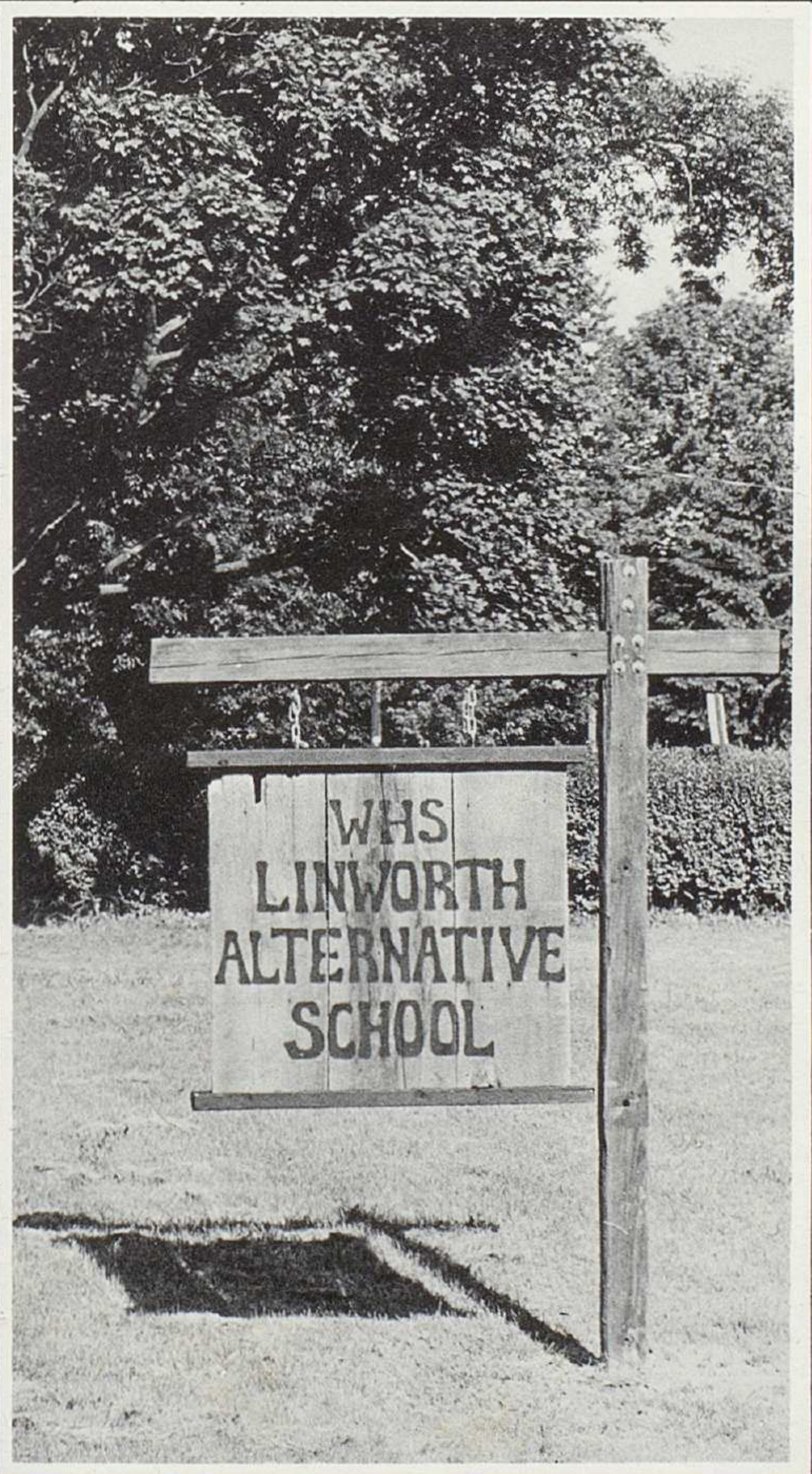


## Linwerth Alternitiv Prōgram— *a project in independent research*
