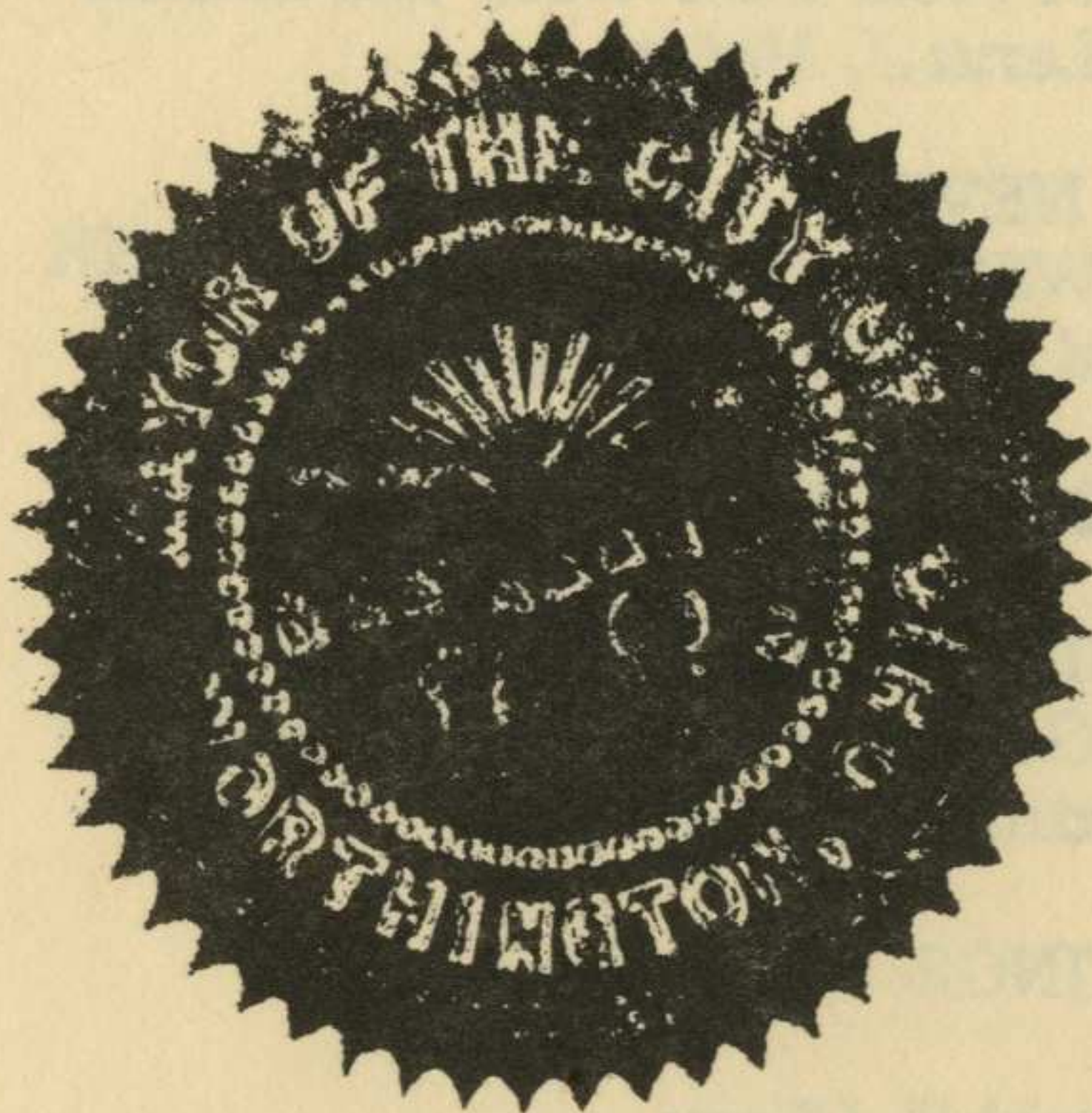
To declare January 19, 1987, as

WHEREAS, Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. was a great religious and social leader and represents a symbol of peace, justice, freedom and dignity for all people; and,


WHEREAS, Dr. King challenged the people of our nation to honor the principles of freedom, equality and opportunity upon which this nation was founded; and,
