



Letter to Mr. L. Steinfeld of Columbus, Ohio from B.
Steinfeld (for Mary Johnson Sessions), 1/7/1900

Subject: A proposition for changes to be made on the storefront of a
drug store at 116 N High St. The storefront is owned by Mary.

Mr. L Steinfeld,

Dear Sir—I submit the following proposition for your consideration for changes to be made of
front window and door to your drug store room. Known as #116 North High St—

To be reconstructed as shown on plan of R.A. Edgar. And in consideration The rent of lease you now
hold and dated April 1st 1899 will be increased to the added sum of three dollars and fifty cents (3.50)
per month, or if the said change shall cost over three hundred and fifty dollars, then a further ___ charge
of ten (.10) per cent on increased cost above 350 dollars shall be added on to the first named sum. Said
payment to be made monthly to confirm. and added to the amount as shown in your present lease
dated April 1st 1899. This agreement to be attached to the lease and ___ become part of the same.
