The parish was visited on Thursday and Fri

day the 28th and 29th of August 1834 by Bishop

McIlvaine. On Thursday afternoon of the above

day, the rite of Confirmation was administered

to eleven persons (see Register of Confirmations)

On Friday On Friday A.M. the Rev. E. Burr Dea-

con and minister of the parish was admitted to the order of Priests by the Bishop Rev Messrs (?) Preston, McElroy, Sparrow, and Suddards being present and assisting Ordination sermon by the Bishop. Lords Supper also by the Bishop

On Friday morning the Sunday School was assembled and addressed by the Bishop.

Services were held morning, afternoon and evening of each day.

Copy of the Sentence of Consecration
of St John's Church

Whereas the church wardens and vestry men of St John's Church in the town of Worthington in the Diocese of Ohio have by an (?) instrument this day presented to me, appropriated & devoted a house of public worship erected by them in the said town to the worship and service of Almighty God, the Father, the Son, & the Holy Ghost according to the provisions of the Protestant Episcopal Church in the United States of America in its doctrines, discipline and worship,

and by a congregation in communion with said Church and in union with the convention thereof in the Diocese of Ohio:

And whereas the said church wardens and vestrymen have by the same instrument requested me to take their said house of worship under my spiritual jurisdiction as Bishop of the Diocese of Ohio and of that of my successors in office and to consecrate it by the name of St John's Church, and hereby separate it from all unhallowed, worldly, and common uses and solemnly dedicate it to the holy purposes above mentioned -

Now, therefore, know all men by these present, that I, Charles P. McIlvaine by divine permission Bishop of the Diocese of Ohio and acting under the protection of Almighty God, have, on this seventeenth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty five, taken the above mentioned house of worship under my spiritual jurisdiction as
(margin note Nov 17th 1835 -)

Bishop aforesaid and that of my successors in office, and in the presence of divers of the Clergy and a public congregation therein assembled

and according to the form prescribed by the
Protestant Episcopal Church in the United
States of America, have have (crossed out) consecrated
the same by the name of St John's Church
And I do hereby promounce and de=
clare that the said St John's Church in the Town
aforesaid, is consecrated accordingly, and there=
by separated, henceforth from all unhallowed
worldly and common uses, and is dedicated to the
worship and service of Almighty God, the Father
the Son, and the Holy Ghost, for reading and
preaching his holy word, for celebrating his holy
sacraments, for offering his glorious majesty
the sacrifices of prayer and praise and thanks
giving, for blessing his people in his name, and
for the performance of all other holy offices
agreeably to the covenant - of grace and salvation
in our blessed Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ,
and according to the provisions of the Proestant
Episcopal Church in the United States of Ameri
ca in its doctrines discipline and worship.
